A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the prohibition of requiring low-wage workers to enter into covenants not to compete and also to require employers to notify potential employees of any requirement to enter into a covenant not to compete.

Summary:

Employers are increasingly requiring their employees to sign non-compete agreements as a condition of employment, even in low-wage jobs where the sponsor/s of this bill do not believe such provisions serve an obvious purpose. This bill contends these covenants can lead to low-wage employees being unreasonably restricted in finding new jobs. This bill would prohibit employers from requiring low-wage employees to enter into covenants not to compete as a condition of their employment.
