Title:

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring third-party food delivery services to agree to reimburse third-party food delivery workers for certain costs related to vehicle crashes that happen during deliveries.

Summary:

This bill requires third-party food delivery services to cover certain costs for delivery workers if they get into a vehicle crash while making a delivery. This includes costs for medical treatment and property damage that aren't covered by someone else. If a delivery service doesn't include this in their contracts, they could be fined \$500 for each contract that doesn't comply, and the delivery workers could get \$1,000 in damages if they are part of a noncompliant contract.
