And he said to them, Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. (Mark 15:16 ESV)

# **Daily Prayer Focus**

### Sunday, October 26: The Lost

- Pray that hearts will be open to receive the Gospel.
- Pray for those who are far from God to encounter His love.
- Ask God to soften hearts and remove barriers to faith.
- Pray against loneliness, depression, and discouragement of past, present, and future cross-cultural workers.

#### Tuesday, October 28: The Nations

- Pray for local, regional, and global peace, justice, unity, and salvation.
- Ask God to break down walls of division and hatred.
- Pray for the poor, the oppressed, and the marginalized.
- Pray for revival among the nations, that hearts would turn back to God and be renewed in power and love, transforming communities by the Spirit's fire.

## Monday, October 27: The Church

- Pray for unity and strength within the global church.
- Ask God to empower believers to be bold witnesses.
- Pray for pastors and leaders to have wisdom and quidance.
- Pray for pastors' self-leadership that comes from a place of identity and wholeness centered in Christ alone.

# Wednesday, October 29: The Next Generation

- Ask God to raise up godly leaders for the future.
- Pray for children and young people to encounter Christ.
- Pray for boldness to be the hands and feet of Jesus among their peers.
- Pray for protection against ungodly influences.
- Pray for the healing of the mind, body, and soul.
- Pray for churches, organizations, and individuals working to alleviate suffering.

# Thursday, October 30<sup>th</sup> Prayer Focus - Community | Prayer Walking

**Prayer walking is more than exercise.** It is a spiritual act of intercession. A unique opportunity to bombard heaven, on behalf of others, *as you are going!* 

**Join us for a dedicated Prayer Walking event from 6 AM to 6 PM EST.** We invite you to help us cultivate a spirit of prayer by participating in a continuous circle of prayer around the Peace Baptist campus throughout the entire day!

We encourage you to sign up to pray on-site at the church if you can.

However, our main goal is to pray together, whether you are physically present or not. If you can't join us in person—especially our online community—please feel free to pray wherever you are, whether at home, at work, or in your neighborhood.

As you walk, listen to the Holy Spirit, bless people, neighborhoods, churches, pastors, people groups, leaders, and more. Pray against spiritual roadblocks, heart issues, areas of pain and hurt - as the Spirit leads.

#### PRAY FOR PEACE BAPTIST CHURCH'S KINGDOM EXPANSION

- Pray for trust in and surrender to God's guidance regarding the expansion of our campus and Kingdom initiatives, which include housing, medical services, youth-focused educational outreach, and other community services.
- Pray for our partners involved in this Kingdom work, especially Frontline and our corporate partners.

#### **HOW TO PRAYER WALK:**

- Plan ahead. Choose a block of time to pray (i.e., 10 15, 20 30 minutes). Choose where to walk, and commit.
- **Prepare your heart.** Invite the Holy Spirit to guide your steps and open your eyes to what He wants you to notice, as you walk.
- Walk in pairs or small groups. Two or three together help with focus, safety, and unity in prayers.
- Walk with intention. Have a conversation with God about what you see in homes, schools, businesses, churches, and community spaces. Be open to places God might be calling you to walk. Also, what do you hear, feel, smell, and touch?
- Stop. Sit down. Pray. As you are led, stop, sit down, or pray in a certain area or room. The point is to listen to the Spirit.
- **Stay alert.** Keep your eyes open to your surroundings and to the Spirit. Pray for peace, healing, and hope wherever you walk.
- Alternate silence and words. Some moments may call for quiet listening, while others call for spoken prayers of declaration.
- Use scripture. Speak God's Word as you walk.
- **Keep it simple.** You don't have to pray long or cover every issue. Just lift up what God brings to your heart.
- Close with gratitude. Thank God for what He has revealed to you, and ask Him to keep working in that part of your life. Thank Him ahead of time for the Holy Spirit's presence and power throughout the Global Impact Celebration.
- **Reflect and share.** Afterwards, write down what you sensed or discuss with others how God might be calling you to respond. Find someone to hold you accountable.

**Questions to consider:** What will I do differently as a result of what I have experienced during my time of prayer? How might God be calling me to serve during the Global Impact Celebration Weekend? How might God be calling me to serve in local, regional, or global missions?

# Daily Prayer Focus - cont'd

#### Friday, October 31: Your Personal Response

- Be still and silent. Listen for God's voice by setting aside, at least, 15 - 20 minutes.
- Review your responses to the prayer-walking questions.
- Reflect on your week of intentional prayer. What stands out? What is your next step of obedience in missions?
- Journal your thoughts.

#### Saturday, November 1: Global Impact Celebration

- Ask God to draw many to Himself through the Global Impact Celebration.
- Pray that passion and hearts are ignited to evangelize and make disciples.
- Ask God to multiply every act of obedience beyond what seems possible.
- Pray for God's presence and power during the Global Impact Celebration.

## **Sunday, November 2: Worship Services**

- Pray for an *unusual*, *supernatural* anointing on the worship and Word for both services.
- Pray for faith to rise as people commit to pray, give, and GO!
- Pray for long-lasting impact and transformation in lives and communities.
- Pray that people hear, understand, and respond to the Life Commitments and Faith Promises, with joy.
