Safeguarding -Day of Prayer for Survivors and Victims of Abuse.

Each year the Catholic Church in England and Wales holds a Day of Prayer for Survivors and Victims of Abuse. This year it falls on **Tuesday 5th May**.

This year we pray particularly for those affected by Domestic Abuse and Violence.

The physical danger domestic abuse presents to life is clear. A woman is murdered by a partner or ex-partner every five days in the UK. Between three and 10 women die by suicide each week due to domestic abuse. It is important to recognise, too, that men can and are be victims of domestic abuse. Abusers can also perpetrate spiritual and coercive abuse, disrupting their victims' relationships with God and the Church. This can lead victims – adults and children – to feel guilt and shame that push them away from the support that the Church has to offer.

At its best, the Church can – and should – be a safe haven where support is available for victims and survivors so that they can live life without fear and begin to experience the life in abundance Jesus came to bring. This hope is what we pray for this year.
