National Stroke Week encourages us to know the FAST (Face, Arms, Speech and Time) signs of stroke so that we can save a life. Using the FAST test involves asking these simple questions:

- Face Check their face. Has their mouth drooped?
- Arms Can they lift both arms?
- Speech Is their speech slurred? Do they understand you?
- Time Is critical. If you see any of these signs call 000 straight away.
