



January is Pro-Life Month

Throughout this month, many Pro-Life Masses, prayer vigils, and marches will take place across our country. The **first March for Life began in 1974**, one year after the Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade decision on January 22, 1973, as a peaceful witness to the dignity of every human life.

The **Annual March for Life in Washington, DC** will take place **Friday, January 23rd**. The day begins with a **Rally at the National Mall**, followed by the **March at 1:00 p.m. (ET)**, walking past the U.S. Capitol and toward the Supreme Court.

This year's theme: *"Life Is a Gift"* — celebrating life from conception to natural death.

Last year's crowd was estimated at nearly **100,000 participants**.
