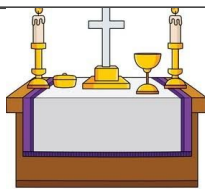

Food Pantry:

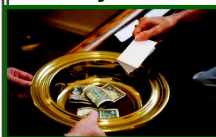
