The Exaltation of the Cross

The Exaltation of the Cross refers to a Christian feast day, celebrated on September 14, that commemorates the veneration and triumph of the cross, a symbol of Christ's sacrifice, victory over sin and death, and ultimate redemption for humanity. It specifically marks the historical events of the discovery of the True Cross by St. Helena in the 4th century and the dedication of a church on the site of the Holy Sepulchre in 335 AD. The feast calls believers to embrace the cross as a source of hope, strength, and eternal life, recognizing that even our struggles can be transformed into opportunities for deeper connection with God's love.

A classic Italian movie re-mastered and re-released to celebrate the canonization in 2025 of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901-1925). Frassati was a handsome, athletic and fun-loving young man from a rich, aristocratic Italian family who turned from a life of privilege to one devoted to working with the poor, suffering and homeless, and was a courageous witness of Christian faith and charity to many others. An avid mountain climber, Frassati exemplified a great love for life, nature and humanity. He was a leader of youth in Italy in Catholic social justice and charitable organizations, and is the patron saint of World Youth Days. He died of the polio virus at the age of 24.
