Saint Bruno of Cologne (c. 1030–1101) was a German theologian and the founder of the Carthusian Order, a monastic community combining the solitary life of hermits with the communal life of monks. He protested a corrupt archbishop, left the secular world for religious life with six companions in the **Chartreuse Mountains**, and later advised **Pope Urban II** before establishing a second monastery in Calabria. He is celebrated for his devotion to silence, prayer, and contemplation.
