Tip: Pray a decade of the Rosary this month for life. Attend a local Life Chain or pro-life event together.

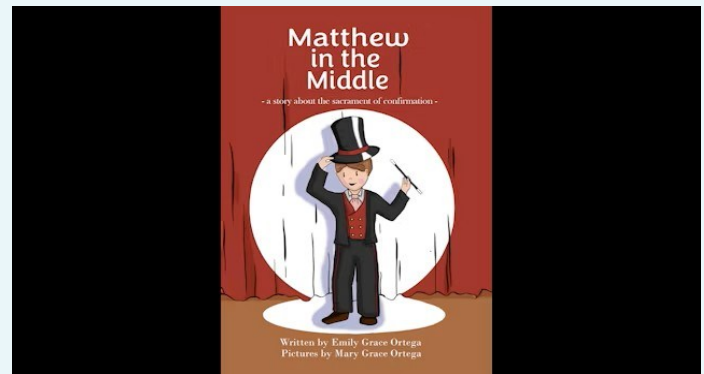
