Important - Please Read Procedures for lost or forgotten passes:

If you forget or misplace your photo ID Season Pass, you will be required to purchase a restricted ticket for \$40.00 upon each return until your photo ID Season Pass is remembered or found.

Allowing another person to use your pass is considered theft of services. Criminal charges may be pressed. The person who loaned the pass will lose all pass privileges. The person using the pass will pay an administrative fee and the cost of a lift ticket that day.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR PASS AT ALL TIMES.

Requirements for registration by mail / email:

Due to our ID system, photos must be taken at or emailed to Willard Mountain at info@willardmountain.com. If necessary, photos may be taken on first day of skiing. A physical signature is also required prior to issuance of a pass.

Skiers/Snowboarders Responsibility Code

There are elements of risk in skiing /snowboarding that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce:

- 1) Ski under control and in such a manner that you can stop or avoid other skiers or objects.
- 2) When skiing downhill or overtaking another skier, you must avoid the skier below you.
- 3) You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4) When entering a trail or starting downhill, yield to other skiers.
- 5) All skiers shall use devices to help prevent runaway skis.
- 6) You shall keep off closed trails and posted areas and observe all posted signs.
- 7) You must never intentionally jump or fall from a chair lift.

WARNING TO SKIERS AND SNOWBOARDERS: Downhill skiing, as other sports, contains inherent risks, including but not limited to the risk of personal injury, including catastrophic injury or death or property damage, which may be caused by variations in terrain or weather conditions or surface or sub-surface snow, ice, bare spots or areas of thin cover, moguls, ruts, bumps or other persons using the facilities; or rocks, branches, forest growth, debris, roots, stumps, or other natural objects or man-made objects that are incidental to the provision or maintenance of a ski facility in New York State. New York State law imposes a duty on you to become apprised of and understand the risks inherent in the sport of skiing, which are set forth above, so that you may make an informed decision of whether to participate in skiing notwithstanding the risks. New York also imposes additional duties upon you, to which you must adhere, for the purpose of avoiding injury caused by any of the risks inherent in skiing. A complete list of these responsibilities is posted at the area under the New York State Industrial code rule #54 (safety in skiing). If you are not willing to assume all of these risks and abide by these duties, you must not participate in skiing or riding at this area.

Willard Mountain strongly suggests the use of a helmet, at all times, while skiing and riding.
