

Welcome to the HANDLE® Level 3 Screening Training Course

The HANDLE Screening Training is to teach you how to carry out a HANDLE Screening and create a customized HANDLE Program to address client's presenting concerns and system issues you discover. This is for clients with mild to moderate challenges from the age of five and for adults of any age. The client is expected to be verbal, able to hold a pencil, follow instructions and can do some tasks at a table for approximately 45 minutes. Completion of all course requirements enables you to be receive a Certificate of Completion as a HANDLE Practitioner from The HANDLE Institute®, and to use the HANDLE Screening Tool and Activities professionally.



What is covered in this course?

- Participants receive a personal HANDLE Screening, providing insights into their own unique ways of functioning in the world, and an individualized program of HANDLE activities. This will also serve to provide the experience of being the client during a Screening and Presentation.
- Further exploration of the concepts taught in Levels 1 and 2. Building a deeper knowledge and understanding of the Foundations of the HANDLE Paradigm. Review and exploration of the activities taught in Levels 1 and 2. This material is covered in a prerequisite / corequisite Applied Level 2 course.
- 13 new HANDLE activities, that can be applied to enhance functions for those you screen; as well as how to modify the activities to meet the needs of your clients.
- Expansion of your capacities to live into the behaviors being presented by the client.
- Learning the Screening process:
 - the Screening Tool tasks;
 - making sense of observations and intake information,
 - creating a Program;
 - Presenting your findings, all this
 - with a Non-Judgmental attitude, Gentle Enhancement and a systems perspective.
- Supervised practicum work with clients: These are supervised screenings with clients, in which you will work with your peers as a team. You will screen at least two clients and assist your teammates with their Screenings. This will give you the opportunity to identify irregularities in systems, determine appropriate recommendations, and present the findings to clients and families. The training will include working with clients who are in the same space as the Screening - student. The teams will join the Screenings via Zoom.

You'll be expected to demonstrate competence in:

- Demonstrating each activity: Explaining and demonstrating variations and the reasons for them; explaining which systems are being required and supported; what the vestibular components of the specific Activity are; what presenting concerns a client might have that



prompts you to recommend this activity; and what precautions should be taken and watched for.

- Demonstrating a non-judgmental attitude.
- Administering the HANDLE Screening Tool competently
- Analyzing the findings of the Screening, and filling out a Screening Summary Report for the client.
- Developing an balanced, individualized Program of HANDLE Activities.
- Presenting the findings and teaching the client their Program.
- Teaching the client to recognize their own signs of stress (State Changes).
- Suggesting compensatory measures.
- Performing at least three (3) additional HANDLE Screenings - post course work that you will submit to your instructor for review.
- Completing your take home exam (Interactive Learning Tool).
- If you are unable to demonstrate competency during the course you will have other opportunities to do so, but there may be an **additional cost**.

What does it take to complete the course and become a HANDLE Practitioner?

- 100% attendance
- Completion of all Homework assignments – Some of these may be substantial. The homework between classes is to support your integration of class information.
- Competency-based assessments: ILT, Screening Tool, Screening Summary, Presentations, Program creation, and checked off on all Activities
- Affiliation with The HANDLE Institute

Course Schedule:

- The Course will begin on **Saturday October 10th, 2026**. We plan to finish the classroom portion of the course on **August 28th, 2027, including Clinicals**
- Class will **meet weekly from 12:00 pm – 2:00 pm Eastern USA Time – This may change depending on the time zones of the students, but will NOT meet before 10 am Eastern USA time. No Class December 26th for Holidays. The class time will be fixed by the time in the Eastern USA – as adjusted for seasonal time changes.**
- **Clinical Schedule is planned for the 2nd and 3rd weeks of both July AND August.**
- During the Clinic, we will meet multiple times per week, above and beyond the regular class meetings. You will each Screen and Present to hopefully 2 clients during the Screening Clinic. You will be part of a Team, such that the students who are observing will be taking notes and supporting the student who will be the doing screening as needed.
- **Applicants must have:**
 - A computer and reliable internet for Zoom meetings.
 - Completed Levels 1 and 2 sometime within the last two (2) years. If it has been longer than 2 years, you are required to review them online by the end of the first two (2) months of the Level 3 course. (Please request Access to the Student Portal at the bottom of my HOME page)
 - Read or listened to the Fabric of Autism **prior** to the start of the course.



Cost:

Course Fee \$4,000 (USD – including Deposit and fees to the HANDLE Institute for use of Intellectual Property)

Deposit: \$400 (US) non-refundable deposit with submission of the application.

Payment options: (After \$Deposit)

1. Pay in full at time of acceptance to the course: total of \$3,600 (plus already paid deposit)
2. 10 monthly payments of \$382: total \$3,820 (includes \$220 in online processing fees)
3. If you need a different payment plan, please schedule to talk with me. I can do Zelle payments in the USA with no fees.
4. I understand that the exchange rate for some countries may make the course fee prohibitive. It is important to me that HANDLE providers exist in countries around the world so everyone has access to this approach. If this applies to you, please contact me to discuss payment options.

Potential Additional Expenses:

- You must have a copy of The Fabric of Autism by Judith Bluestone. Sold through www.HANDLE.org in the Resources Section (books). I recommend the PDF also as it is searchable. It is available in Print on Demand, PDF and Audio formats. It is also available through Amazon on Audible.
- You will need to have access to a printer (at home or at a print shop).
- Have a paid subscription to DropBox so you can access class and other recordings.
- Have Activities props - balls (for Sunrise Sunset + one of similar size with a smooth surface that can be inflated and bounce), hoops (smooth segmented are recommended to accommodate adjusting size), a blow pipe (and other blowing options), a rope, a flashlight, bead for Bead Transfer. I'll send details as needed.
