Today this remnant accepts Jesus as Messiah. The Apostle Paul urged Gentile believers to attract Jewish people to the gospel ([Romans 11:11](#)). One day this mission to His chosen people will conclude when the Lord brings the nation of Israel to repentance and the knowledge of his Son. Scripture declares, "all Israel will be saved" ([Romans 11:25-29](#)).



THE GIDEONS INTERNATIONAL is the result of a meeting between two men who wished to band commercial travelers together for evangelism. What began in 1908 as an Association of Christian businessmen placing Bibles in hotel rooms has evolved into an expanding mission to provide Scriptures to all people in nearly every facet of life. Today, the Gideons have taken more than 2 billion Scriptures in more than 95 languages to 200 countries, territories, and possessions across the globe.


