SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Leader #1:

Last Sunday, we lit the first candle in our Advent Wreath, the candle of HOPE.

People:

We light it again as we remember that Christ will come again to fulfill all God's promises to us.

Leader #2:

The second candle of Advent is the candle of PEACE. It is sometimes called the Bethlehem Candle to remind us of the place in which preparations were made to receive and cradle the Christ child.

Leader #1:

It is a gift.

People:

God gives us the gift of peace when we turn to Him in faith.

Leader #2:

The prophet Isaiah calls Christ "the Prince of Peace."

People:

Through the prophets, God asks us to prepare our hearts so that He may enter.

Leader #1:

Our hope is in God and His Son, Jesus Christ.

People:

Our peace is found in Christ

We light this candle today to remind us that Christ brings PEACE to all who trust in God.
