

Statement of Beliefs

The Scriptures: The Holy Bible was written by men divinely inspired and is God's revelation of Himself to man (2 Tim. 3:16-17; 2 Pet. 3:20-21).

God: There is one and only one living and true God who reveals Himself to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit, with distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being (Matt. 28:19).

God the Father: God is Father in truth to those who become children of God through faith in Jesus Christ (John 1:12-13).

God the Son: Christ is the eternal Son of God. In His incarnation as Jesus Christ, He was conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary, He honored the divine law by His personal obedience, and in His death on the cross, He made provision for the redemption of men from sin (Mt. 1:23; Lk. 1:35; Heb. 9:11-12).

God the Holy Spirit: The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of God who exalts Christ, convicts of sin, of righteousness and of judgment (Acts 1:8, 5:3-4; Jn. 16:8-14).

Man: Man was created by the special act of God, in His own image, and is the crowning work of His creation. By his free choice man sinned against God and brought sin into the human race (Gen. 1:26; 3:1-7).

Salvation: Salvation involves the redemption of the whole man, and is offered freely to all who accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior (Rom. 5:6-21; 10:9-10).

God's Purpose of Grace: Election is the gracious purpose of God, according to which He regenerates, sanctifies, and glorifies sinners. All true believers endure to the end (Jn. 10:27-30).

The Church: A New Testament church of the Lord Jesus Christ is a local body of baptized believers who are associated by covenant in the faith and fellowship of the gospel...and seeking to extend the gospel to the ends of the earth (Acts 2:37-47).

Baptism & the Lord's Supper: Christian baptism is the immersion of a believer in water (Acts 8:35-38). It is an act of obedience symbolizing the believer's faith in a crucified, buried, and risen Savior, the believer's death to sin, the burial of the life, and the resurrection to walk in newness of life in Christ Jesus (Rom. 6:1-23). The Lord's Supper is a symbolic act of obedience whereby members memorialize the death of the Redeemer and anticipate His second coming (1 Cor. 11:23-30).

Last Things: God, in His own time and in His own way, will bring the world to its appropriate end. Jesus Christ will return personally and visibly, the dead will be raised; and Christ will judge all men in righteousness. The unrighteous will be consigned to hell and the righteous will receive their reward and will dwell forever with the Lord (Mt. 25:31-46).

Family: God has ordained the family as the foundational institution of human society.

Marriage is the unity of one man and one woman in covenant commitment for a lifetime (Gen. 2:2:18-25). The husband and wife are of equal worth before God, since both are created in God's image. The marriage relationship models the way God relates to His people. Children, from the moment of conception, are a blessing and heritage from the Lord (Ps. 127:3; 139:15-16).

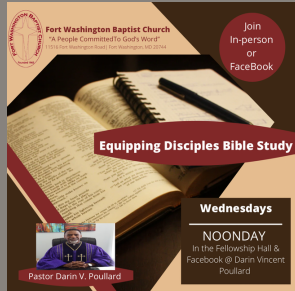

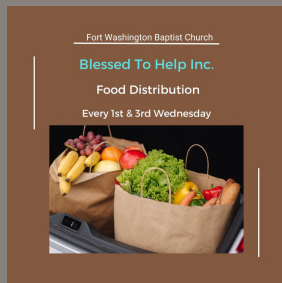

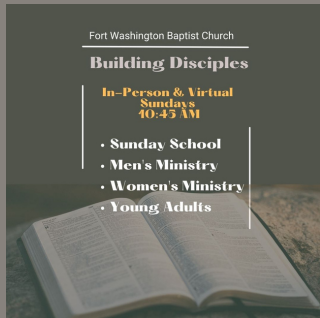
