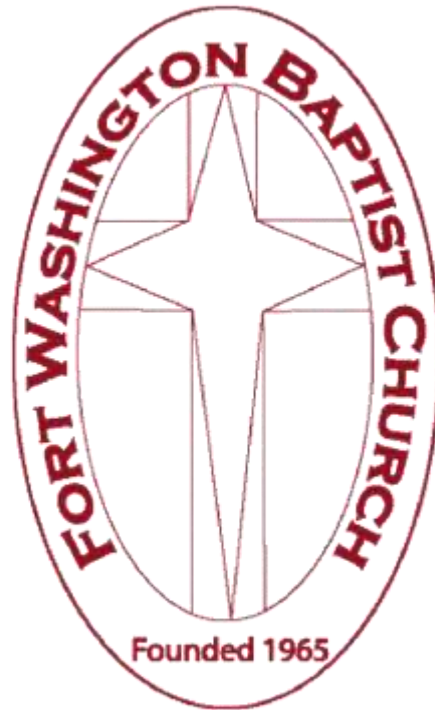

Reverend Davis faithfully served as the senior pastor of Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church in Washington, D.C., for an impressive 47 years, retiring in 2024 as Pastor Emeritus. Under his visionary leadership, the church experienced significant spiritual growth, expanded its missional outreach, and enhanced its financial stewardship and assets.

An accomplished preacher, Reverend Davis has delivered sermons on major stages around the world. He has also served on the boards of various faith-based organizations and remains active in numerous ecumenical, civic, and social associations.

Reverend Davis was blessed with a devoted partner in life and ministry, the late First Lady Margaret Davis, who transitioned to be with the Lord in November 2021. They were the parents of five daughters and are the proud grandparents of ten grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren.

Reverend Davis is deeply aware of God's hand in his ministry and holds fast to the truth of Zechariah 4:6b: *"...Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, saith the Lord of hosts."*
