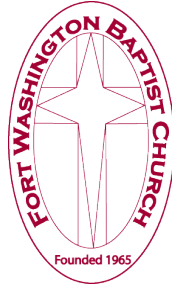

Rev. Dr. Judie Perry Johnson is an Associate Minister at Fort Washington Baptist Church, where she serves in the capacity of Pastoral Counselor under the leadership of Pastor Darin Poullard. She brings more than 27 years of ministry leadership and over three decades of professional experience in healthcare and behavioral health to her calling in counseling, preaching, and teaching. Her ministry is rooted in providing hope, healing, and encouragement through biblically grounded and clinically informed care.

Rev. Johnson founded and led multiple ministries throughout her years of service. She currently serves as Chair of the Set Free Ministry and is an active partner in Fort Washington Baptist Church's Women's Ministry, where she is known for her leadership, compassion, and organizational excellence. In addition, she is a founding member and the President and Chief Executive Officer of Blessed to Help, Inc. (BTHI), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization committed to addressing food insecurity, providing literacy training, and supporting the holistic needs of residents in Prince George's County, Maryland. She is a native Washingtonian and enjoys saying that she is a product of Southeast Washington.

Rev. Johnson earned a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Alderson-Broaddus College and a Master of Science in Health Care Administration from Central Michigan University. She earned a Doctorate in Christian Counseling from Andersonville Theological Seminary in 2005. In 2021, she completed a Master of Divinity degree and also holds a Master Certificate in Applied Project Management from Villanova University.

Rev. Johnson was licensed as a minister in 2005 and was officially ordained by Fort Washington Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Poullard in 2016. She retired in 2011 after 33 years of distinguished service in nursing leadership, including senior roles at St. Elizabeths Hospital and the National Institutes of Health, and participation on a national research review board.

She is married to Dr. Spencer Johnson and is the proud mother of two, Maurice and Jasmine. Rev. Johnson believes that effective ministry flows from the Word of God—and that the true witness of faith is not only in teaching the Word, but in faithfully living it.

Scripture Reading

Isaiah 10:27 (NKJV)

27 “It shall come to pass in that day that his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, and his yoke from your neck, and the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.”

Galatians 5:16-19, 22-23 (NLT)

16 So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves.

17 The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions.

18 But when you are directed by the Spirit, you are not under obligation to the law of Moses.

19 When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures,

22 But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

23 gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!
