SECOND CENTURY COMMITMENT UPDATE

We are grateful to share good news: even after the heavy rain this week, there was no water in the sanctuary. That is a meaningful sign of progress and a reminder of why this preservation work matters.

The new slate has arrived and is now staged in the parking lot. Roof work continues in the coming weeks, and the roof portion of the project is expected to be complete by mid-August.
