



New Parish Religious Education Program

We're excited to announce a new direction in faith formation at Sacred Heart and St. Jude parishes: A Family of Faith. Program Highlights:

- Monthly Parent Sessions (September-May):

- **Children's Classes:** Kids learn separately through engaging activities led by catechists.
- At-Home Lessons: Families reinforce learning together using the Parent's Guide and Activity Book.
- **Community Gatherings:** Monthly events for the whole family to build friendships and celebrate faith.

This flexible program is designed for children in **grades 1-8**, but **all parishioners are welcome** to participate! You can get involved by volunteering to lead a parent session, assist with children's classes, or help organize community events. The year will be divided into two parts; the first focusing on What One is Seeking, Why One Seeks God, and Why a Church, among other topics. The second part of the year will focus specifically on the Creed, the Sacraments, the Theological Virtues, Prayers, Discipleship and Mission. WOMEN'S GUILD EVENTS Join Us for Prayer & Friendship



A group of women are planning to car pool to the "She Shall Be Called Woman" program at Sacred Heart. If you are interested, see Karen Tornambe or Ginger Best.






