
RECTORY DEMOLITION A quick update on the rectory

The Sacred Heart of Jesus parish finance council, parish pastoral council, and parish staff all recommend demolition and future planning for a new rectory. An electronic survey was sent to over 250 parishioner email addresses with 91% of respondents in agreement that this is the most responsible path forward for our parish.

At St. Jude, the parish council recommends renovating their rectory for long-term use.

Your recommendations will now be sent to the Diocese of Harrisburg, and we will await their guidance before taking next steps.



A FAMILY OF FAITH

October Overview




