FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly Most Holy Name Catholic Church, Garfield, NJ Second Sunday in Ordinary Time January 14, 2024

"John was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by he said: 'Behold the Lamb of God.' The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. Jesus turned and saw them following him and he said to them, 'What are you looking for?' They said to him 'Rabbi... where are you staying?' He said them, 'Come and you will see.'"

We picture this meeting, we hear the conversation, and Jesus asks us the same question, 'what are YOU looking for?' Take time to answer, for we are asking Him to come to us and accompany us on our journey as His disciples. It was Andrew who informed Peter and brought him to Jesus. Jesus had a special job for him. Every disciple of the Lord is another Andrew. To whom can I speak and invite to know Jesus?

First Reading: 1 Samuel 3:3b-10, 19

This powerful story describes Samuel, who at the time was the servant of the high priest. The Lord called out to Samuel, who twice thought Eli had called him. They gradually realized that it was the Lord who called for him. So the third time Samuel answered and the Lord remained with Samuel as he grew.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20 Paul explains to the Corinthians that their body is a temple of the Holy Spirit. He tells them to avoid lewd conduct, and glorify God by keeping their bodies pure.

Gospel: John 1:35-42

John told two of his disciples that Jesus is the Lamb of God. They turned and followed him, immediately curious and attracted to him. Andrew told his brother Simon about Jesus. Simon also came to meet Jesus, who renamed him Cephas, or Peter.
