Discussion Questions

- Who comes over to play or hang out at your house?
- What helps your friends or cousins feel special:
 - Sharing your toys or keeping them all to yourself?
 - Asking what they would like to play or telling them what to play?
- Does your family invite others over for a BBQ or dinner? How do you get the house ready so your guests feel welcome and special?
- Has there ever been a time when family or friends had to sleep over because of a snow storm? Or they were moving?
- When you meet someone new, how should you introduce yourself and help them feel welcome?
- Ever walked into a room and didn't know anyone? It can be scary. What makes you feel welcome, like you belong?



Every person wants to belong. Even someone who likes to be by themselves still wants to belong with family and friends. We make people feel special when we say Hi! and welcome them in.

Matching Game | What Belongs Together?

Supplies:

- Category and Matching Cards
- pencils

We're going to play a matching relay game.

Place the category pictures in a row on a table at one end of the room. Turn all matching cards upside down and arrange in columns and rows on a table on the other side of the room. Campers must pick a matching card and run it to the category card table and match it up under the correct category's column.

To make all of this more challenging, include only half of the image on the matching cards.

If there is extra time in Small Group, Campers can pick a few matching cards and draw the other half of the object.

Category Cards include:

- Camping with the image of a tent
- Beach Vacation with the image of a sun hat
- Amusement Park with the image of a ticket
- Zoo with the image of a panda eating bamboo
- Theatre with the image of stage, red curtain, microphone on a stand

Matching cards include images of:

Camping: hiking boots, bug spray, lantern or flashlight, matches, canoe,

Beach Vacation: beach chair, sand bucket and shovel, bathing suit, goggles, beach umbrella

Amusement Park: bag with goldfish swimming around, big teddy bear won at a fair game, roller coaster chair, Merry-Go-Round, Ferris Wheel

Zoo: rhino, baby lion cub, elephant, peacock, zebra

Theatre: wig, costume, playbill, shoes, orchestra, theatre chairs, ticket, mask

Connection to Theme and Game

It would be silly to put a beach chair in the zoo in the middle of the rhino's pen, wouldn't it? It would be silly to take the goldfish you won at an amusement park midway with you on your camping trip, wouldn't it?

We made the objects belong together in the right groups.

In the same way, you belong when you make others feel welcome and special, like they belong with you.

Review Bible Story

In our Bible story today, how did the woman make Elisha feel welcome in her home?

She gave him good meals and made a room for him to sleep.

How Jesus Welcomed Others In

The woman in our Bible Story reminds me of Jesus. Jesus always welcomed others.

He didn't send anyone away even if they were blind, sick, or begged for money.

The Bible tells how Jesus helped two blind men see again. They were shouting for Jesus and when others told them to be quiet, Jesus asked them, "What do you want me to do for you?" (Point to verse 33) "We want our sight".

Jesus had compassion on them. He felt sorry for them, so He touched their eyes and immediately they could see.



Jesus loved it when children played around Him as He taught.

The Bible says, when others wanted to send the children away, Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me."

Jesus is the best example of loving and welcoming others in.

People feel special when they belong.

Even at home, we want our family members to feel like they belong. That's today's Take Action!



At home, every time someone enters the room you are in, clap and cheer for them and say, "Whoohooo! __name__ is in the room!"

Celebrate, clap, and cheer for each other like they are famous.

The first time you clap and cheer for them, "Whoohoo! __name__ in here!" they might look at you like you're crazy, but secretly, they will love it because they want to belong too.

Write the names of your family who you clap for in the clapping hands in your Playbill. Bring your Playbill back tomorrow and show your clapping hands to your Crew Leader.

Special Note:

When Campers show their Playbill on Day 4, ask.

- What response did you get when you clapped and cheered for your family members?
- How do you think you brightened their day?
- Who liked it most?
