# **Supplies**

- White fan veil for each camper
- Water
- Vinegar
- Empty spray bottle
- Fabric dye (red and yellow)
- Yellow and red sticker gems
- Marker

#### **Premade**

1. Premix fabric dye in spray bottles some yellow some red.

#### **Instructions**

- 1. Have campers write their name on the handle of the fan veil
- 2. Decorate base of fan using rhinestones, paint markers.
- 3. Campers decorate veil of fan using fabric dye spray.

# **CRAFT | SOCK PUPPETS**

#### **Parlando Crews**



#### **Objective**

To create a puppet like creation and put life into your character!

God created us all in the beginning- he created us all in his image! We all belong together, because we are all made by God!

## **Supplies**

- Felt sock puppet cutout (multicoloured)
- Red felt (for tongue)
- Fabric glue
- Glitter glue
- Pom poms
- Stickers
- Pipe cleaners
- Feathers





#### Instructions

- Add googly eyes to your puppet- what do they look like? How many eyes do they have? Are they big or small? Do they pop out?
- Add some eyebrows to your sock puppet with glitter glue- do they have big or small eyebrows?
- Add a mouth to your puppet using red and/or pink felt- what colour is it? Is it long or short? Big or small?
- Add hair to your sock puppet- what type of hair do they have? Is it pipe cleaner hair, or feather hair? Is there a lot of hair, or just a little bit?
- Add a nose to your sock puppet with a pom pom- do they have 2 nostrils, or only one? How big is their nose?
- Think about something that you can add to your puppet to make it look more like your character. Does it have a cowboy hat? Does it have a little tail? Use some red/pink felt, pipe cleaners, or glitter glue to make your character come to life!

# **CRAFT | SET CREATION**

# **Bombershay Crafts**

## **Objective**

To work together to learn how a set is created, and how one can design a set to effectively portray a story with purpose and meaning!

## **Supplies**

- Paint (blue, black, white, brown, grey, red, yellow)
- Plastic sign material
- Door handles (6)
- Pipe cleaners
- Kraft paper roll (brown)
- Styrofoam round foam blocks (2-4)
- Wooden dowels (1-2)

#### Instructions

- Create the LOCKERS (2 racks of 3 ideally):
  - Create using paint (blue/black/white) on cardboard/plastic material (same materials as the camp signs)
  - Attach handles with hot glue
- Create the HIGH SCHOOL BANNER:
  - Writing in black and white with pops of colour around
  - Name the high school
  - Create a chant/logo to put onto the school banner
  - Decorate with
- Gather and create props:
  - Weights (1-2):
  - Create using 2 styrofoam circular "plates" and
     1 rod attaching them with hot glue
- Paint them with grey and black paint
- Nerdy Glasses (2-3)
  - create using 3 pipe cleaners
