

CRAFT | OLIO | MICROPHONE



Objective:

- Musicians unite! Musicians have so much creativity- from coming up with rhythms, to writing lyrics, to playing instruments in different ways and way way more!
- These microphones are a way of showing how creative you can be! Let the decoration creation begin!!

Supplies:

- Toilet paper roll
- Kid friendly scissors
- Hot glue, a glue stick and elmers glue
- Tape
- Tinfoil
- Washi tape
- Styrofoam ball
- Gems and stickers

Instructions:

1. Cover the toilet paper roll with a piece of colourful construction paper by securing it with a glue stick on both sides, and a piece of tape to tape the side down.
2. Cover the styrofoam ball with aluminum foil by folding it down in the center. Gather all of the aluminum foil down so it is sticking out on one side.
3. Put the side sticking out of the aluminum ball down the toilet paper roll. Secure with 2 pieces of clear tape crossing over the top of the aluminum ball. Secure the parts connecting from the toilet paper roll to the aluminum ball with a piece of washi tape around the top.
4. Decorate the handle of the microphone with sticky gems and markers! Voila!



CRAFT | PARLANDO | TIME MACHINE NECKLACE



Objective:

To create a fun, time travelling based lanyard that can be worn throughout their skit!

Instructions:

- Cardboard Rings/Circle
 - Cut out 2 circle rings (1 bigger, one smaller), and 1 smaller circle to go in the middle of the time machine, using cardboard.
 - Line up the three cardboard pieces. Punch holes in 12 o clock and 6 o clock of the inner and mid pieces to connect them later in the process.
 - Punch holes in 3 o clock and 9 o clock of the mid and outer pieces to connect them later in the process

Supplies:

- Cardboard circles (1 big circle ring, 1 mid-sized circle ring, and 1 small circle)
- Scissors
- Gold or yellow string
- Hole punch
- Hot glue sticks
- Hot glue gun
- Metallic gold and silver markers
- Key ring
- Black lanyard (1 per camper)
- Neon paint markers

Instructions:

1. Draw an hourglass on the smallest circle.
2. Wrap the inner circle and the two cardboard rings in gold string. Get a crew leader to help you glue down the start and end pieces of the string to stay sturdy.
3. Line up the rings (smallest in the middle going outwards, similar to a darts board)
4. To connect the smallest circle and middle circle ring, run string through the 12-o clock and 6 o clock of both pieces. Connect and tie the pieces together using a piece of string.
5. To connect the middle piece and large piece, run string through the 3-o clock and 9 o clock of both pieces. Connect and tie the pieces together using a piece of string.
6. Attach a key ring to the pendant through one of the pre hole punched circles on the outer ring. Attach the key ring to the lanyard.
7. Decorate the lanyard with neon paint markers to show the swirly effects of going backwards in time!!



MADE TO WONDER

Objective:

- To create a beautiful set that looks intricate under a blacklight, on different surfaces with designs to show the creation story!
- To act alongside white mittens that Bombershay will wear for the acting parts to show these different moving tableaux

Supplies:

- Black light (glow in the dark)/neon paint (pink, yellow, orange, blue and green)
- Paint brushes
- Paper bowls (for paint application/mixing)
- 3-6 large cardboard/plastic pieces (for a set)
- White mittens/gloves (1 pair per student)
- Black straws (20-40)
- Paper Mache Planets (premade):
 - Balloon
 - Newspapers/recycling paper
 - White glue
 - Large bowl
 - Small bowl
 - Small tray/shallow container
 - Spoon
 - Paint brush
 - Paint mixing stick (medium length)

Instructions

1. Inflate balloon to medium size
2. Tear paper into large pieces (3 layers)
3. Prepare the paste by mixing 2 parts white glue with 1 part water. Mix well.
4. Soak the paper with the paste
5. Place the paper on the balloon and smooth the edges of the pieces of paper with your finger/a paint brush
6. Repeat a couple of times to make multiple layers (2-3 is ideal)
7. Let the papier mache dry (takes 2-3 days)
8. Once dry, pop the balloon
9. Add a medium

Instructions

- Set Building:
 - Assign campers to different cardboard boxes to paint together:
 - Two are the night sky (moon/stars), the other two are daytime (sun, land, ocean, etc.)
 - Use reference photos below to pencil trace and paint the cardboard/plastic signs
 - Paint with a variety of blacklight and/or neon paints!
- Planet Construction:
 - Trace your design onto the planet
 - Paint in with a variety of blacklight and/or neon paints!
 - OPTIONAL: Add a ring to the planet:
 - Cut a ring that is big enough to hold the planet inside of it
 - Distribute evenly and glue 8-10 1-inch straws in a circle around the balloon
 - Glue the cardboard ring to the other side of the straws.
