VERA

Well, I am taking this art class all week and we are learning about different kinds of art.

Yesterday, I learned to paint. Remember my Mona Lisa of a Camper?!

Today we are learning about mosaics. Have you ever heard of mosaics?

Host

Yes, mosaics are a special way to decorate floors or walls with designs using small, broken pieces of stone, coloured glass, tile or shells. Then mortar is used to fill in the gaps between the tiles.

VERA

That's exactly it! In my art class today, we are making a mosaic floor tile and I'm in charge of the mortar.

Host

That is very exciting, VERA.

VERA

I am just amazed at how a bunch of broken tiles turn into a beautiful picture.

Host

I agree. It's amazing that the artist can see the big picture of what they want to create when all they have to work with are small broken tiles.

That reminds me of a story I know of a man whose life became broken. Everything went wrong for him. But with God, his life turned out beautiful.

Host

Samson's life seemed broken because he did not keep his promises to God and he did not make good choices, but God still loved Samson and used him to rescue the people of Israel from the Philistines.

Each part of your life such as time at school, with your friends, the sports and clubs you belong to, winning or losing a tournament, vacations, falling off your bike, learning a new language, all of these are like small mosaic tiles that when put together, make a beautiful picture.
