Bible

Supplies

- Playdough

Prepare In Advance

- Crew Leader marks this verse in Bible before Small Group Time
- Crew Leader is ready to share when you were creative with chores or schoolwork.

Digging Deeper

- How do you like to be creative?
- Which do you like to do: painting, colouring, building a skateboard ramp, taking pictures, dancing, singing, acting, or writing stories?
- What crafts do you like to make?

Connection to Bible Story

It is fun to be creative, and God loves it when you let your creativity shine.

You were made to be creative, just as God is creative. Every time you are creative, you show off God's creativity.

(Show Campers from the Bible) Here in the Bible, it says, "Sing a new song to Him (God). Play with skill (that means instruments), and shout with joy." Psalm 33:3 NIRV

You are in the right place to sing songs, dance, act, and be creative! I'm happy you are here at VISTO.

Get Creative with Playdough

Split your Crew into two or three smaller groups. Give each group 3-4 containers of Playdough to build with. Give 3 minutes to work together to create one of the following:

- a beach scene
- a playground
- breakfast
- a treehouse

Give time for everyone to see what each group made.

GET CREATIVE EVERYDAY

When we think of creativity, we think of painting, singing, building, and crafting just like how Bezalel and Oholiab built and decorated the Tabernacle. (Reference Exodus 31:1-6)

But there are other times in our day when we can be creative.

We can be creative when

- we are bored and don't know what to play
- waiting for video game time
- something is hard
- we clean our bedroom
- practicing math or spelling words

Special Note for Crew Leaders

Share times when you were creative with daily tasks

Then ask Campers:

Could being creative turn a time when you are bored into fun?
Will you choose to be creative even when it's a task or chore that you don't really want to do?



Choose something you do every day - that might be boring.

Your challenge is to turn that one thing you do every day into fun. Do something fun and creative.

Draw or write down in your Playbill what you did and the fun way you did it.

Bring your Playbill back to VISTO tomorrow and tell your Crew Leader how you were creative.
