Allow each Camper to share, and encourage Campers to listen when someone else is sharing

Special Note:

If a Camper doesn't yet know what they are talented or good at, say:

God has a super special gift or talent in store for you! I believe it! Your job right now is to have fun trying many different things (like crafts, sports, and opportunities like VISTO where you are singing, dancing, and acting). As you try these different things, you will discover what you are good at or really like doing.

Connection to Bible Story
