

CRAFT: Tie-Dye



Lesson Objectives

Dream Big with today's Tie-Dye. Show your students the following cloud pattern to create their t-shirt to exemplify that God's dreams for us are out of this world! An opportunity for campers to grow in relationship with their crew leaders and members and the chance for campers to engage in a creative outlet.

Supplies

- White VISTO shirts
- Fabric dye (Orange, Teal, Blue)
- Dye plastic bottles
- Elastics
- Clothes hangers
- Clothing racks
- Tarps (x5)
- Window screens (x3)
- Large buckets (x6)

Instructions

- Campers will receive their VISTO camp shirt with their name on a piece of painters tape
- Campers will wrap their name tape around an elastic to make a nametag
- Then campers will take turns dunking their shirts into a bucket of water to get them damp
- Campers will then take their shirts on the table and scrunch them up to make a crumpled cloud effect
- Have campers add a few elastics around the shirt to keep it loosely in place
- Once their shirt has been tied, they can take it outside to the tie dye area where they will use spray bottles to spray all around both sides of their shirts
- Campers will leave their shirts to set like that for 24hrs before staff remove elastics, rinse shirts, and hang to dry.
