

CRAFT | Unique Cookies

Olio Crews



Objective: This cookie helps remind us we are all unique in our own separate ways! It gives campers an opportunity to create a practical prop for their acting scene too.

SUPPLIES

- Brown coloured felt (precut into circles, 2 per camper)
- Craft glue
- Cotton balls/fabric stuffing
- Puffy paint (premade into different colours)
- Shaving cream + glue + food colouring
- Decorations (beads, pom-poms, sequins, foam stickers, etc.)
- Playbill glossary of item characteristics
- Paper bowls
- Paintbrush
- Red/blue/yellow food

PREPARE

PUFFY PAINT (Premade in the morning):

1. Mix equal amounts of shaving cream and white glue until you have the texture wanted
2. Distribute small portion on each paper bowl and distribute to campers

COOKIE CUT OUTS (Premade beforehand):

1. Take the two brown coloured felt circles and lay them on top of each other
2. Outline the outside of felt pieces with hot glue 5/6ths of the way and stick the two felt circles together. Make sure to leave a tiny slit for kids to stuff cotton balls into it!

SET UP:

At each campers spot, preset the cookie cutouts, white puffy paint (in a paper bowl), a paintbrush, 10 cotton balls, and an identity decoration cutout. Put all of the decorations out at each table.

UNIQUELY ME!

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Stuff the pre-glued felt cookie with 10 cotton balls.
2. Have a crew leader hot glue the slit closed so that the two felt circles are fully connected.
3. As one crew leader hot glues the slits in the cookies close, another crew leader will walk around with food dye asking each camper what colour of icing they want to use for their cookie. Put a couple of drops of the colour they choose and mix together with the paintbrush.
4. Write your first name and last name in sharpie on the bottom of the cookie with a sharpie.
5. Apply the newly coloured puffy paint to the top side of the cookie.
6. Use the identity decoration glossary to show your personality on your cookie!
7. Paste the Uniquely Me! Decoration Glossary sheet into you Take Action Playbill!

Uniquely Me! Decoration Glossary (INSERT INTO PLAYBILL)

- Puff paint: My favourite colour is _____!
- Letter Beads: My name is _____!
- Star sprinkles: I like to perform (singing/acting/dancing)!
- Multicoloured sprinkles: I like to draw and colour!
- Candy Buttons (buttons): I like to cook and bake!
- Gummy worms (pipe cleaners): I like to read!
- Mints (swirly beads): I like to play video games!
- Jellybeans (beads): I am kind!
- Gummy bears (jewels): I am brave!
- Caramels (Pom poms): I am funny!
- Candy hearts (heart beads): I am loved for who I am!

CRAFT | Hawaiian Leis

Objective: Learn more about Moana and Polynesian culture while creating something with immense meaning for their acting.

History: Hawaiians used leis to distinguish themselves, and was used as a symbol of peace between tribes with the opposing chiefs sporting the lei. Leis are special flower necklaces that are given to show love, friendship or welcome. Making a lei is a way to show kindness and aloha- a word that means love and piece. A lei symbolizes a connection between the giver and the receiver- connection that is governed by affection or respect. In this culture, people do not refuse an offered lei. They bow their head to accept the offering.

SUPPLIES

- Scissors
- VISTO coloured cupcake liners (PRECUT into flowers, 8-10 per camper)
- Hole puncher
- Brown paper drinking straws (PRECUT into 1 inch pieces)
- Glue/double sided tape
- Yarn or string (PRECUT)
- Large Wooden Beads
- Felt Flowers Pre-Cut

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Prepare the cupcake liners (flattened, trimmed edges, etc.)
2. Punch holes in the center of each flower
3. Stick a piece of plastic straw into each hole punched flower with glue/tape
4. Once all 8-10 pieces are assembled, attach them to a string and tie it into a lei!

Decorate a mirror by attaching the variety of decorations with fabric glue, hot glue, rhinestone glue
