

SHOWCASE SCRIPT



Host: Hi everyone, and welcome to VISTO Performing Arts Showcase! (insert action)
We're here to celebrate your campers and all they've learned and shared.

My name is Tabs, and I'm the Camp Director at VISTO.

This week, we saw your campers grow in courage, confidence & skills! They shared stories, made new friends, and helped remind us that God made each one of us in His image— God Made Me Amazing And Wonderful!

Call & Response: **UNIQUELY WHO? YOU. UNIQUELY WE! ME**

(campers begin to get into their opening positions for Camp Dance)

Affiliate/Board Member/Sponsor: Thanks so much for joining us at VISTO's Uniquely Me! VISTO Showcase!

K2K Productions has been working with students for over 20 years—offering year-round programs and camps in both Woodstock and Stratford!

Maybe you've seen our shows like Frozen, Finding Nemo JR or Sister Act JR? This coming season, we hope you'll join us at Dare to Dream in Nov & Dec 2025, and during Spring 2026, Seussical and Freaky Friday. And the inaugural performance of Lion King in Stratford, Ontario

Before we begin, we want to say a big thank-you to our amazing partners and donors who make camps like VISTO possible—especially sponsors like Erb Signs, Adams Building Centre and _____ (choose one based on audience).

K2K is a charity rooted in transforming young people and sharing God's love. We're here to help every student learn more about who they are, where they belong, and their purpose.

Host: Now without further ado, we would like to present UNIQUELY ME! VISTO campers. But first- say it with me showcase families! Uniquely who? YOU! Uniquely we? ME!

(cue, I'm Finally Me, Camp Dance)

VERA (walking in with her mirror): Oh, hi everyone! Wait, let's try that again

"Hi everyone" "Hi VERA!!" Are you ready? (Go backstage and then re-enter)

"Hi everyone!" (wait for response). AWESOME!!!

It is so nice to meet you UNIQUELY ME! families & friends!

UNIQUELY ME!

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CL 1: Hi Vera! It was so much fun learning about being unique this week- but why do you have a mirror??

VERA: Well, I need to be extra, extra sure I don't have any hot dog or skittles in my teeth- but also because I wanted to see me! This week we were learning about how we are all super, duper unique and have a BIG purpose!

CL 2: Right! Just like we learned about the bible story of Gideon this week- he was the smallest, and poorest in his family, but with God's encouragement, he was able to rescue the people of Israel by being himself and playing a trumpet!

VERA: God and Gideon are SO COOL!!

CL 1: You betcha they are! And remember what we talked about on Day 4?

VERA: HMMM.... OH YEAH! We learned about the fruits of the spirit! Like apples, and pears, and blueberries and grapes and -

CL 2: Not exactly VERA. We learned what the fruits of the spirit are, but they aren't fruits you eat. They're not even regular looking fruits!

VERA: They aren't? I thought they were like... bananas... (points to banana)

(A camper in a banana outfit comes out).

FRUITS OF THE SPIRIT SKIT (Bombershay/tbd.):

Banana: Oh! Hi everyone! My name is BANANA. I may be yellow and delicious, but I also share with others, and LOVE my neighbour as myself. Am I a fruit of the spirit?

Camper 1: Yes! Love is one of the fruits of the spirit! And who are you?

Grape: Hi everyone! My name is GRAPE. I like to go to Canada's Wonderland and go on the roller-coasters and have fun with others. It fills me with JOY! Am I a fruit of the spirit?

Camper 2: Yes! Joy is one of the fruits of the spirit! And... oh... who are you?

Tomato: My name is Tomato. People cannot tell whether I am a fruit... or a vegetable. And that makes me angry... and want to DESTROY!!! Am I a fruit of the spirit?

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Other fruits: Uh.....

Camper 1: Not quite! The fruits of the spirit are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control!

Camper 2: Each fruit is a way God wants us to live—in how we act, speak, and treat others. And... we shouldn't want to destroy.

(Olio campers get into beginning positions.)

Camper 1: When we live with love, joy, peace, and ALL the fruits of the Spirit, we start to see who we really are—and why we're here!

VERA: OHHH!!! Right! Thanks for that - fruits, vegetables and campers! When we show love, joy, patience and more—we become the special person God created us to be. We become UNIQUELY ME." who? (you!) Uniquely we? (me!)

(VERA and Campers/Fruits/Vegetables walk offstage)

CL 1: Thank you for that amazing skit campers and VERA! We have to keep celebrating who we are!

Transition Scene + Performance of "What I Am"- by Olio

CL 2 (Parlando Leader with a notebook in hand, leading a small conga line of Bombershay campers): What I am is smart! What I am is awesome! What I am is beautiful ;)

(The conga line hits an epic cool guy pose on "beautiful")

CL 3 (Other Parlando Leader): What are you doing?

CL 2: I am saying all of the things that make me, me, just like the Olio campers told us!

Parlando Camper 1: There are so many things that make each of us unique!

Parlando Camper 2: Definitely! This week we learned so much about what makes us who we are- let's take a look!

Recap Video (house lights off)

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Transition Scene + Performance of “How Far I’ll Go” by Parlando

CL 3 (Parlando): Wow, it’s so wonderful to see how far we can go if we just believe in ourselves!

CL 4 (Parlando): So true! Oh, hey _____! What do you have there?

Take Action! Camper: This is my Take Action playbill! Taaaaaaake action! (cue “take action” action!) and here’s my Take Action Wristband (hold arm up).

CL 3 (Parlando): What is Take Action all about?

Take Action! Camper: Take Action helps me apply what I learned at camp and live it out at home, with my friends and family! I know that sometimes I learn a lot but never practise it or live it out! So (hold wristband arm up) Take the stage, live the change.

CL 4 (Parlando): What was your favourite “Take Action” you completed this week?

Insert Take action testimony.

CL 4 affirms the camper and something specific about their story,
their courage, honesty, vulnerability.

Call & Response: **“Uniquely who? You! Uniquely We? Me!”**

CL 4 (Parlando): _____ camper name, thank you so much for sharing your experience with us. Campers and parents, did you know that the Take Action QR code is the same every week of the summer? So even next week and the week after that, you can watch VERA’s video and do the take action at home in your Playbill- come and show us at another week’s showcase!

CL 3 (Parlando): I agree- Take Action is so amazing ____ and ____ (parlando CL’s name + take action camper)! When we celebrate who we are, we stand out!

Transition Scene + Performance of “Stand Out” by Bombershay

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VERA: Wow, that was SO POWERFUL Bombershay – you are beautiful artists. It can be hard for us to figure out who we are in the world sometimes. Like do I want to become a really fast runner like Usain Bolt?? Or do I want to become an Opera Singer? The choice is IMPOSSIBLE!!!

CL 1: You're absolutely right VERA! We learned so much from our UNIQUELY ME! week - including the reminder that we have so many people who love and support us, and who want us to succeed!

Let's take a look at what we learned this week!

CL 2: At the beginning of the week, we learned how we are all wonderfully made by God by going all the way back to the story of creation! Then on days 2 and 3, we learned about the prodigal son, and how deeply we are all loved by God just like the Father loved his son.

We learned about Jesus and how we can become more like God!

We learned about ourselves, and became confident in knowing "Who am I?"

VERA: That's AWESOME! So through God and our relationships with others, we can all accept what makes us amazing and wonderful? Because we are all amazing and wonderful and I am UNIQUELY ME!
