Bombershay | Acting Scene

SONG: Good Day

Prop: Chain-Link Cuffs

Campers enter and form a straight line across the stage.

Camper 1: Stress

Camper 2: Worry

Camper 3: Fear

Camper 4: Pressure

Camper 5: Doubt

Camper 6: Comparison

Camper 7: Disappointment

Continue as needed. With each word, campers pull slightly against their individual chains.

All Campers: STUCK.

Camper 8: Stuck under grey skies from situations, expectations, and fears.

One at a time, campers step forward.

Camper 8: Sometimes I worry about fitting in.

Camper 9: I compare myself to everyone else.

Camper 10: I feel like I'm not enough.

Camper 11: I let fear make my choices.

Camper 12: Sometimes bad days feel bigger than God.

As each camper speaks, they connect their chains together until everyone is linked.

All Campers (building):

What if I fail?

What if I don't belong?

What if things don't work out?

What if I can't do it?

The group grows increasingly tense. A single camper enters through the centre.

Centre Camper: But what if today could be different?

Pause.

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Centre Camper: What if I could find the sliver of blue in the grey sky?

Pause.

Camper 13: What if it could be a good day because I choose joy?

Camper 14: "This is the day the God has made."

Camper 15: "Let us be joyful and glad in it."

Camper 16: Not because everything is perfect.

Camper 17: But because God is with us.

Camper 18: His joy is stronger than fear.

Camper 19: Because I know him

One by one campers remove their chains and place them at the front of the stage.

All Campers (strong): It's a good day.

Music begins: Good Day.
