

CRAFT | “Good Day” Chains

Bombershay Crews



Objective

- To visually represent choosing joy and a “good day”
- To create a powerful physical moment that reinforces the theme of choosing joy
- To give students a meaningful prop that connects to the message

SUPPLIES

- Grey craft foam strips
- Gold, black and silver paint markers
- Brass fasteners
- Velcro dots or strips (adhesive-backed)
- Scissors
- Hot Glue
- Elastic strips for wrist attachment (x2 per camper)

PRE-MADE

- Cut foam into long strips to create the “chain links” (about 6 inches long x20 per camper, and 10” long x2 per camper). Estimate for 20 campers a week.

START THE PARTY!

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INSTRUCTIONS

1. Loop the strips and attach the chain links together using brass fasteners (two per piece of foam) to create at least a metre of chain per camper
2. Paint or decorate the links, adding grey and black shading and silver highlights for a metal look. Campers can also add words from their script onto their chains.
3. On the final chain link of each end of your long chain, overlap links slightly and attach them using Velcro at each connection point
4. Test the connection to ensure it holds lightly but can be pulled apart easily (these will be used to attach to the other campers beside us in the line during Showcase)
5. Attach two points of the middle of the chain to a wrist cuff (elastic loop) so it can be worn.
6. Use during the scene by holding or wearing the chain and removing near the end
