

CRAFT | Joy Goggles

Olio Crews



Objective

- To help students understand that joy is a way of seeing the world
- To explore how choosing joy can change how we see situations and people
- To remind students that we can look for what is good, fun, and full of life
- To connect perspective with faith: choosing to see the way God sees

SUPPLIES

- Thick craft foam sheets (bright colours)
- Goggle template (pre-cut)
- Scissors
- Coloured cellophane (pink, yellow, or other bright colours)
- Thick, colourful elastic rope (for strap)
- Hole Punch
- Foam letter stickers (glitter or bold colours)
- Foam shapes stickers (stars, hearts, suns, rainbows, clouds, moons)
- Rhinestones or gem stickers
- Feathers
- Small decorative stickers (flowers, smiley faces, etc.)
- Metallic markers (gold, silver, white)
- Beads or charm pieces (stars, gems, etc.)
- String or jump rings (for attaching charms)
- Glue sticks
- Hot glue (leader use)
- Strong tape (optional reinforcement)

PRE-MADE

Cut out goggle shape from craft foam, cut out eye holes, and hole punch for string

START THE PARTY!

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Attach coloured cellophane behind each eye opening to create “joy lenses.”
2. Attach a braided cord or rope to each side to create a wearable strap.
3. Add main lettering using foam stickers (e.g., “JOY” across the top, “CHOOSE JOY” along the bottom if desired).
4. Decorate the goggles using foam shapes, stickers, and metallic markers.

Encourage layering with bright, joyful symbols like stars, hearts, rainbows, and suns.
5. Add rhinestones or gem stickers around the lenses and across the frame for extra detail.
6. Attach small charms (bells, beads, stars) to the sides using string or jump rings to add movement and sound.
