GAME | WE'RE ALL SUPERHERO'S

Theme: Using our gifts to help those around us.



Instructions: Each camper gets to create a unique "superpower" (not flying or strength, but real-life qualities—kindness, courage, creativity, problem-solving). Campers will work in their small groups to create a scene where a big problem arises (prompt provided), and they must work together to solve it using their strengths. Each character must use their "superpower" at least once to succeed!

Scenario Prompts

The town's spagnetti factory exploded. Now, everything is covered in noodles—cars, houses, even the mayor. How will they clean it up?

The school principal got stuck in a giant bubble. Every time someone tries to pop it, it just bounces away.

All the animals at the petting zoo have escaped. They have taken over the grocery store.

The town's biggest slide suddenly turned into lava. Now no one can use the playground.

The library books are alive. They keep running away from kids who try to read them.

The town's supply of ice cream has melted... in the middle of winter. How will they bring it back?

All the socks in the city have disappeared. No one can find a matching pair, and people are panicking.

The sun won't set anymore. It has been daytime for a whole week, and people are too tired to do anything.

The town's mayor turned into a giant chicken. Now they only communicate in clucks—how will anyone understand them?

Scenario Prompts
