

# CRAFT | PAPER MACHE

## OLIO CREWS



### Objective

- What does it look like to feel happy? What does it look like to feel sad?
- Sometimes we feel sad, and that's okay! When we are reminded of our purpose and do things to uplift others, we know that anything is possible and we can cast our worries away!

### Supplies

- Small paper mache balloon
  - Balloon
  - Newspapers/recycling paper
  - White glue
  - Large bowl
  - Small bowl
  - Small tray/shallow container
  - Spoon
  - Paint brush
  - Paint mixing stick
- Precut orange felt triangles ("Rays" of sun)
- Cotton balls
- White glue
- Yellow/orange and grey paint
- Black Paint

### Premade Paper Mache Balloons

1. Inflate balloon to small/medium size
2. Tear paper into large pieces (3 layers)
3. Prepare the paste by mixing 2 parts white glue with 1 part water. Mix well.
4. Soak the paper with the paste
5. Place the paper on the balloon and smooth the edges of the pieces of paper with your finger/a paint brush
6. Repeat a couple of times to make multiple layers (2-3 is ideal)
7. Let the papier mache dry (takes 2-3 days)
8. Once dry, pop the balloon
9. Add a medium length paint

### Instructions

1. Paint one side of the paper mache balloon yellow, and the other side grey
2. For the sunny side:
  - Glue 5-10 triangle rays onto the sunny side, all around the face
  - Attach googly eyes and a smiley face
3. For the cloudy side:
  - Glue 5-10 cotton balls around the face of the cloud
  - Attach googly eyes and a frowny face
4. Decorate the paper towel stick with markers and stickers!

# CRAFT | SUPERHERO

## PARLANDO CREWS



### Objective:

To find their own superhero! What makes your super? What gives you purpose? How can you share that gift with others?

### Instructions:

- Create your own superhero!
- Grab a white mask
- Decorate your mask with your super powers!
  - EX: Think about what makes your super hero super? Do you run really fast? Maybe you have lightning coming out of your mask! Do you love to grow plants? Maybe there are flowers coming out of your mask!
- 3. When your mask is finished, grab a set of arm bands and decorate with paint, foam pieces, etc!

### Supplies:

- White masks
- Foam
- Cardstock paper
- Glue
- Tape
- Arm bands (sun sleeves for kids)
- Paint Markers
- Stick on Gems

# CRAFT | PROP BUILDING

## BOMBERSHAY CREWS



### Objective

- To teach Bombershay students what brings light to their lives, and how they can share that life with other people around them!
- To create a prop that is personal and tells a story through its use onstage!

### Supplies

- Mason Jar (with lids)
- Glass paint liner (?)
- Stain glass paint
- Black cardstock
- Faux candle
- Rope
- Knife/scissors

### Instructions

- Draw on mason jar using the glass paint liner to create a design!
- While waiting for the liner to dry, take the fabric jar cover and cut holes in the top to create a night light.
  - EX: You could draw a certain constellation, such as the Orion which is mentioned in the Bible.
- Paint over the 3D outliner with stain glass paint
- Add a faux candle to the bottom of the mason jar
- ie the fabric jar cover onto the mason jar with a rope. Voila!
