

CRAFT: Tie-Dye

Trace a heart in the middle of the shirt and gather the material around that line. Then section the remaining pieces of the shirt and add colour.

Lesson Objectives

- A safe, low-stress opportunity for small groups to get to know one another (and their section colour)
- An opportunity for students to grow in relationship with their leaders
- The chance for students to engage in a creative outlet

Supplies

- White T-Shirts (given on arrival at craft)
- Elastics
- Washable Markers
- Painters Tape
- Dye (Blue, Teal, Orange)
- Bottles for Dye (6-8 per colour)
- Large Rubbermaid to dye shirts over
- Clothing Rack for After
- Hangers for after
- Garbage bag
- Rubber Gloves
- Wire rack x3
- Bucket x3

Instructions

- Dye needs to be pre-mixed in squeeze bottle
- Have students tie their own shirts with elastic-Each student will have a piece of painters' tape with their name on it
- have the wrap that tape around an elastic to add to their shirt once the dying process is done
- Bring the students outside to squirt the dye onto their shirts on a wire rack over top of a bucket to catch the extra dye
