Digging Deeper

This morning, VERA wanted to win the Super Star Citizen of Woodstock award. The award was looking for people who show kindness, love, care, giving, and helping.

- Anyone ever win an award for being kind, a good friend, or being a helper?
- Tell us how you have shown kindness, love, care, generosity, or a helping hand to someone lately.

This reminds me of what the Bible calls the Fruits of the Spirit.

- Who likes to eat fruit? What are your favorite fruits? (Let the Campers share)
- Did you know that you can have fruit in your life?

Think if a cucumber plant. It starts with a seed in the ground. With good soil, water, and sunshine it sprouts and grows a tall plant. The plant grows flowers that become fruit.

Yummy cucumbers! We are learning and growing. But we don't grow cucumbers.

When you have these fruits in your life, you become more like Jesus.



Fruit Basket Activity

Invite campers to unfold the fruit one at a time.

Love

The fruit of love means to like and care for others very much. You think of them as more important than yourself



Joy

The fruit of joy means to stay happy and content even if things don't go your way

Does joy means that even if it's finally video game time and your device battery is dead, you can still be happy?

Peace

The fruit of peace means to feel calm and not worried. Peace also means a time of no war

What is something we may feel worried about? God can help us to feel calm and at peace about that.

Patience

The fruit of patience means to be able to wait even if the wait feels long

What has been something you have had to wait for? Was it hard to stay patient?

Fruit Basket Activity

Kindness

The fruit of kindness means to be friendly, generous, and thoughtful of others

We all like friends who are kind, right?

Goodness

The fruit of goodness means to be have good morals or wanting to do right.

Does this means telling the truth even if we might get into trouble?

Faithfulness

The fruit of faithfulness means to be trustworthy or loyal. Someone who is faithful can be counted on to do what they say they will do

Keeping our word is so important. People trust us when we are faithful and do what we say we will do.

Gentleness

The fruit of gentleness means to be kind, tender, patient toward others, not pushing or rough

Self-Control

The fruit of self-control means to be in control of your emotions, words, actions

Someone who is self-controlled understands when it is time to talk, time to listen, and time to let others share.

Now when you hear Fruits of the Spirit, remember that we should all have love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control growing in our lives!
