

As I mentioned last weekend, we will be chanting Mass parts during Lent. We use the words *Kyrie eleison* and *Christe eleison* in the Penitential Act—Greek for *Lord have mercy* and *Christ have mercy*.

When the Church shifted away from saying Mass in Greek and more in Latin, the *kyrie* stuck around, almost as if it didn't sound right not to sing it in Greek. We sing it alongside the early Church and the Church throughout the ages. - Fr Kevin
