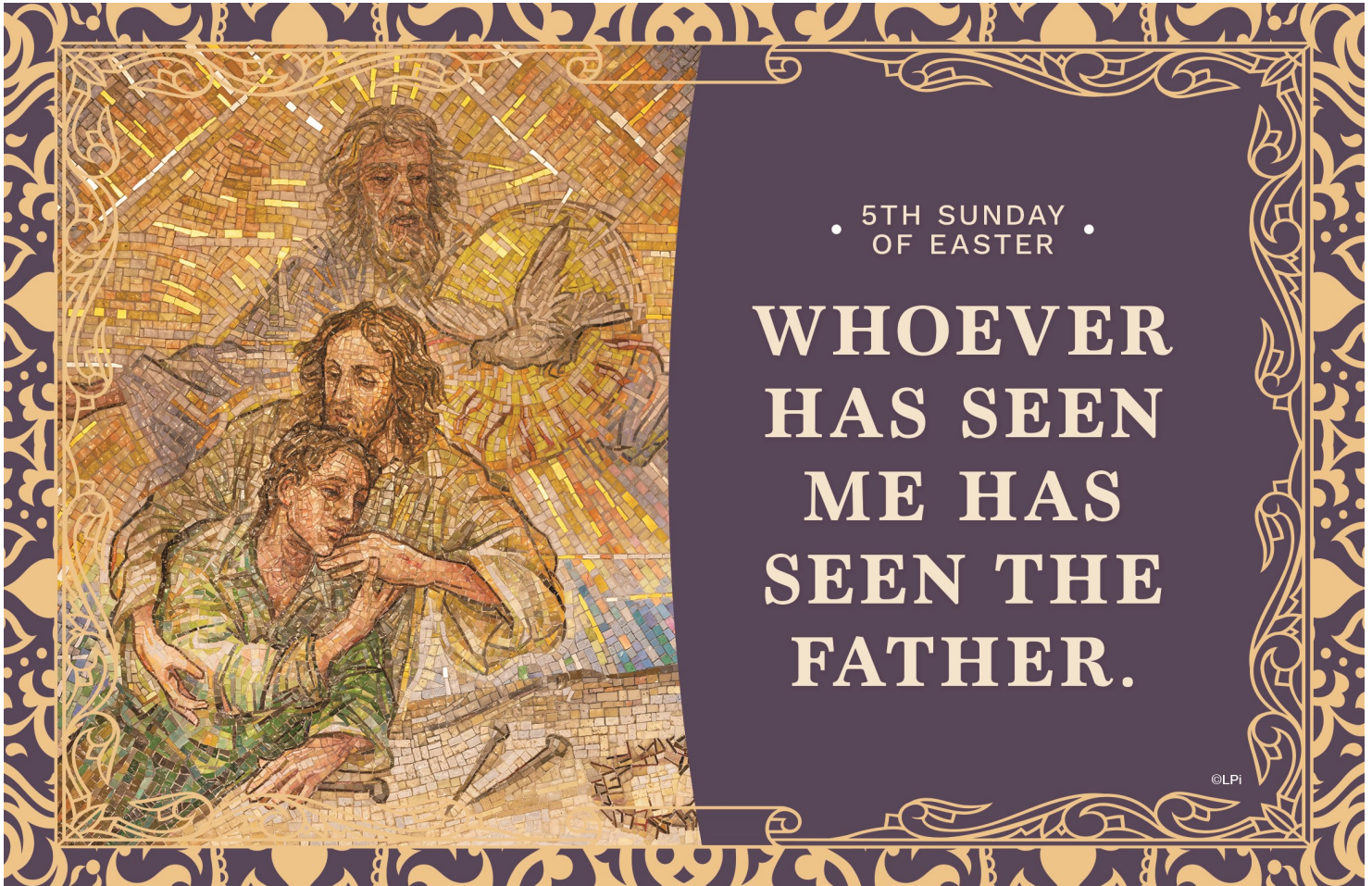

MEMORIAL CROSSES HONORING DECEASED VETERANS

The Catholic War Veterans of Savannah will once again be placing Memorial Crosses in the Catholic Cemetery, (1720 Wheaton St.)

The Crosses will be put in place on May 20th and will remain in place through Memorial Day. Interment at the Catholic Cemetery is not required. There is a one-time fee of \$30 for initial supplies. The Crosses will continue to be maintained and placed in the Cemetery each year thereafter.
