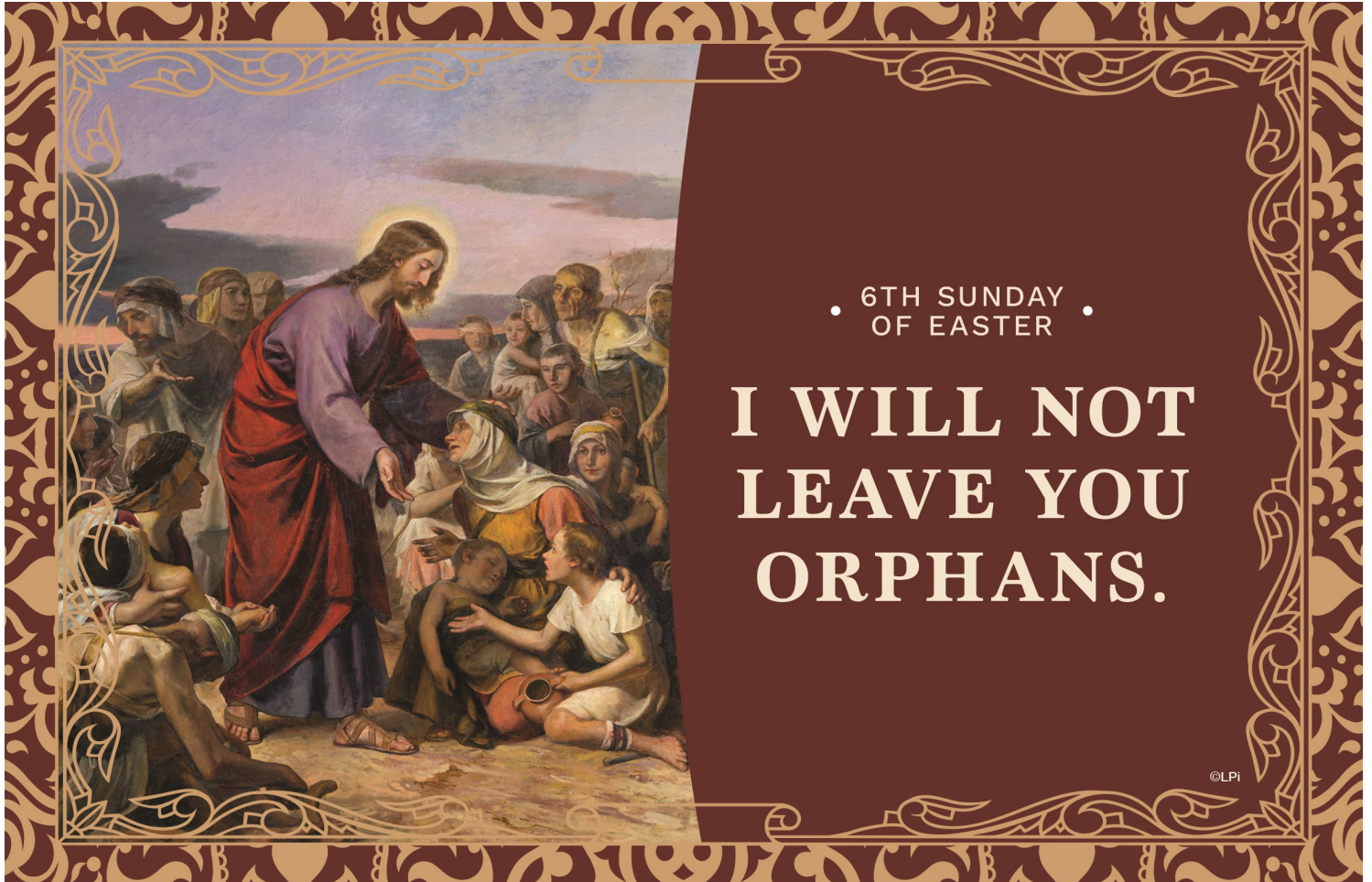

MEMORIAL CROSSES HONORING DECEASED VETERANS



The Catholic War Veterans of Savannah will once again be placing Memorial Crosses in the Catholic Cemetery, (1720 Wheaton St.)

The Crosses will be put in place on May 20th and will remain in place through Memorial Day. If you would like to honor a deceased Veteran contact Melissa King: 912-572-3299 or CWVmemorialcrosses@gmail.com no later than **May 6th**. Request forms are available in the parish office. Interment at the Catholic Cemetery is not required. There is a one-time fee of \$30 for initial supplies. The Crosses will continue to be maintained and placed in the Cemetery each year thereafter.

A Memorial Mass, to honor deceased Veterans, will be celebrated at **6:00 pm Thursday, May 21st**, at the Catholic Cemetery. The Service will be held at the base of the Holy Cross, at the rear of the Cemetery. The Memorial Service will begin promptly at 6:00 pm.
