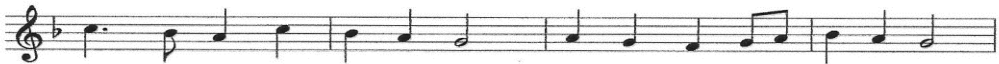

I embrace You as if You have already come, and unite myself wholly to You.



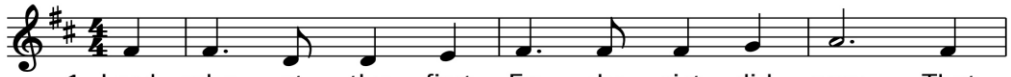
