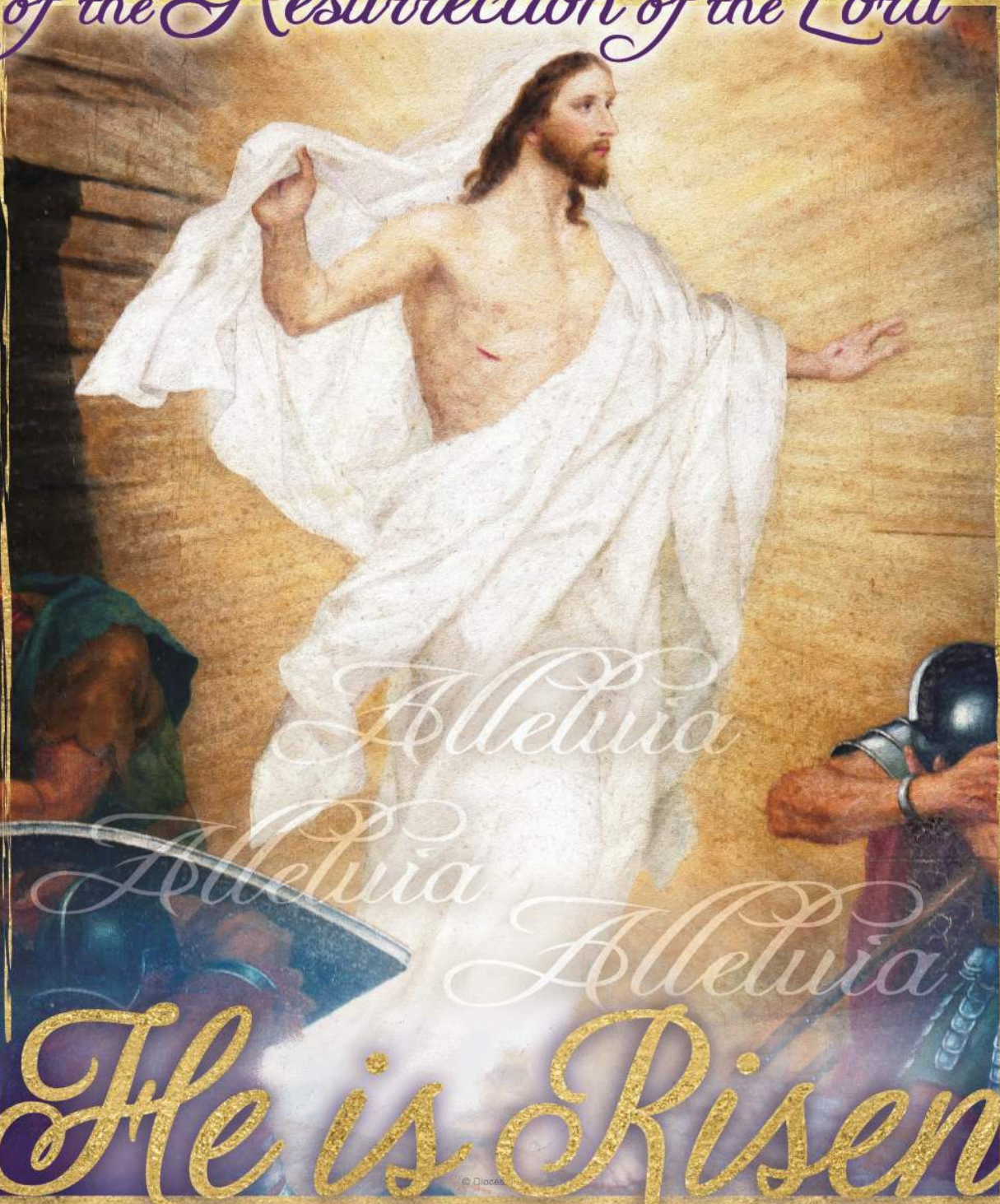

He gifted her with mystical visions, being able to see and talk to her Guardian Angel, conquest in spiritual battles, and at the age of 21, the painful wounds of Christ. Four years later she began a long and painful death from tuberculosis. The mystical experiences continued until she went to her heavenly home. When her tomb was opened 15 days later, her heart was full of blood that burst out from it when cut. There was a burn mark on her chest and her ribs were thrust out for her heart had expanded with God's love. She had claimed that she often felt fire in her heart, recognized later as the Fire of Divine Love, another gift. **St. Gemma, pray that we will offer up our sufferings for the conversion of souls!**
