

**Augustine Warner, great grandfather of George Washington.**

How many people in this room have the first or middle name of Augustine or know someone in your immediate family that has that name?

GW's father was named **Augustine Washington** (1694 – 1743). Where did that name come from?

Augustine Washington's mother surely named him after her father, **Augustine Warner II** (1642 – 1681)

Born in Virginia

Sent back to England to be educated at the Merchant Taylor's school

Colonel of the local county militia

Married Mildred Reade, daughter of George Read, Secretary of the Virginia Colony

The Society gave her a new memorial stone in 2012

Where did Augustine Warner II get this name from? His father, **Augustine Warner I** (1610 – 1674)

Born in Norwich – process of elimination, baptized at church in Hellesdon, Norwich – not far from where Lincolns were baptized

Arrived in Virginia in 1628 at age 17

Became member of the House of Burgesses and the Kings Council

Built the first house at Warner Hall

Where did Augustine Warner get his name from his mother's father, **Augustine Sotherton** (1553 – 1585)

He married Ann Peck at St. Michael at Plea in Norwich

Family silver bought there for Emma's baptism

Buried across the street at St. Andrew's church in Norwich

Alderman of Norwich, son of mayor Thomas Sotherton

Where Augustine Sotherton get his name from? His mother's father, **Augustine Steward** (1491 – 1571) – Born more than 500 years ago.

Mayor of Norwich

Alderman, Sheriff, Burgess in Parliament.

I've been to his house

Buried at St. Peter's Hungate
