Superintendent Abell reported on the following:

- a. With Brett Goodwin off work for the foreseeable future, A.J. O'Brien has been appointed interim foreman/supervisor of the electrical crew.
- b. The board is waiting on a quote from MB Construction to install two valves on the new water line to the nursing home. Once the valves are installed, this project will be complete.
- c. A meeting will take place on October 8th with the landowners concerning the raw water line easements.
- d. An update on the union petition was provided.
- e. The crane at the warehouse needs repairs. A quote will be provided for consideration.
- f. The board will tour the electrical service department and new warehouse on October 16th beginning at 4:00 p.m. prior to the board meeting.

Abell advised the board members of a leave of absence request from Ron Conger to assist a former employer of his, the City of Carrollton, Illinois, with training of new staff. Mr. Conger asked if the leave of absence was allowed that he not be required to take any of his accumulated time. A motion was made by Boulware and seconded Browning to approve the leave of absence requested by Ron Conger for up to 3 weeks. On a call of ayes and nays the motion carried.
