

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS
PALMYRA, MISSOURI

November 19, 2025

The Palmyra Board of Public Works met on the above date in the Palmyra Council Chambers at 5:00 p.m. with President Ernie Boulware presiding. The following board members answered roll call: Ernie Boulware, Gary Stuhlman, and Gerry Maas. Board Member Tim Browning was absent. Also present was Superintendent Brent Abell.

A motion was made by Boulware and seconded by Stuhlman to approve the agenda as presented. On a call of ayes and nays the motion carried.

A motion was made by Stuhlman and seconded by Maas to approve the minutes from the November 6th meeting. On a call of ayes and nays the motion carried.

A motion was made by Boulware and seconded by Stuhlman to approve the bills for the electric, water and sewer departments. On a call of ayes and nays the motion carried.

Superintendent Abell informed the board that the City of Palmyra has its first solar customer.

Council Liaison Steve Bland entered the meeting at 5:08 p.m.

The financial report along with plant and payroll reports were discussed.

Superintendent Abell reported the following:

- a. The primary overhead electrical service at the Palmyra High School tennis courts has been relocated to underground. This will allow the school to expand and add more courts.
- b. The finance committee will be meeting with the department heads on November 20th to review the six-month budget figures and discuss needs for the next fiscal year budget.
- c. The uniforms from Cintas should be in place on November 25th. The FR clothing has been the hold up.
- d. The union petition vote has taken place. The vote came in with 2 yes votes and 11 no votes. A formal letter closing the request will be received from the Department of Labor.
- e. Streetlight bulbs are on order and are scheduled to be received in the second week of December.
- f. The subdivision plat for Greystone Haven South has been reviewed by the city engineer and the three objections/comments have been referred to Four Point Land Surveying and Engineering.

With no further business before the board a motion to adjourn was made at 5:55 p.m.
