

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS
PALMYRA, MISSOURI

June 18, 2026

The Palmyra Board of Public Works met on the above date in the Palmyra Council Chambers at 5:00 p.m. with President Gary Stuhlman presiding. The following board members answered roll call: Gary Stuhlman, Gerry Maas, Tim Browning, and Robert Lovegreen. Also present was Electrical Manager Pete Dames and Water/Wastewater Manager Dustin Smith.

A motion was made by Stuhlman and seconded by Browning to approve the agenda as presented. On a call of ayes and nays the motion carried.

A motion was made by Maas and seconded by Lovegreen to approve the minutes from the May 21st and June 4th meetings. On a call of ayes and nays the motion carried.

A motion was made by Browning and seconded by Maas to approve the bills for the electric, water and sewer departments. On a call of ayes and nays the motion carried.

The financial report along with plant and payroll reports were discussed.

Electrical Manager Pete Dames reported the following:

- a. The digger truck has been delivered and will be placed in service soon.
- b. Dames asked the board to consider spending some funds on a contractor to trim trees ahead of the line crew.
- c. BHMG has been contacted to look at the electrical line loss.
- d. Mark Salter will start working in the electrical department on July 6th.

Water/Wastewater Manager Dustin Smith reported the following:

- a. Updated the board on the status of the sewer line easements.
- b. Updated the board on the status of the raw water line easements.
- c. Discussed the inspection report on the industrial water tower and will obtain quotes on the repairs needed.
- d. The ground storage tank has become a priority for needed maintenance. The roof is soft and the interior is rusting. Smith will attempt to obtain three quotes.
- e. The new effluent meter at the water plant is scheduled to be installed next week.

With no further business before the board a motion to adjourn was made at 6:05 p.m.
