Steel Casket Selection

Metal caskets can be made from base steel of various gauge thicknesses, stainless steel or precious metals. In fact, copper and bronze are renowned for their timeless beauty and elegance. Most metal caskets are referred to as "corrosion resistant", "protective" or "sealed" caskets. They are assembled with a thick rubber strip along the entire length of the lid, thus creating a sealed enclosure preventing outside elements from penetrating the casket.

When it comes to metal caskets, you can pick and choose a unique look by combining features such as colours, finishes and customization options.




Outer Burial Containers / Concrete Vaults
