Our transfer company will safely drive us the 3-4 hours to Mount Camdeboo. Following check-in, we will have time to settle in, explore the fabulous accommodation, the two-17th century Dutch Manor Houses, our luxury rooms. dining room, then meet in the courtyard for lunch / high-tea by the swimming pool

Late afternoon we set off on a 3-hour game drive up on the plateau, returning to the Manor for dinner

This is to be our home for the next FOUR nights. (B,HT,D)



Each day whilst we are on safari in the three game reserves our pattern of activities will be the similar; early coffee and rusks, game drive with a break for coffee and pastries,

Return to the lodge for a sumptuous breakfast, relax or enjoy other activities, probably best to avoid lunch, then high tea around 2:45pm before afternoon game drive with a break for traditional sundowners, beer, cider, wine and nibbles.

After sundowners and as dusk falls we may be lucky enough to witness the thrill of a lion-hunt or watch as a family of hippo emerge from the water for a night of grazing. As nocturnal life begins to stir, return safely to the lodge to freshen up, before a superb evening meal where we can relate and share stories of our day's adventures and experiences.

**There are SEVEN opportunities for food every day, definitely best to avoid lunch!**



Leopards are one of the "Big Five". Leopards are also reclusive, allusive, nocturnal hunters, and if you are lucky, you may see one during the day resting up a tree, so always check-out substantial trees with wide limbs.

A male Leopard weighs around 95 kg, and can lift 1.5 times his body weight, say, a prey 140 kg antelope on one claw, whilst climbing up a tree with his other three claws.

A Leopard may be under that low bush that you were considering "peeing" behind. So, DON'T, OK?

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Mount Camdeboo invites you to share its people's love for this sometimes harsh, yet always spectacularly beautiful, vast land of contrasts. What started out as one family's dream has evolved into the creation of a family of a different kind. Managers Richard and Daron Slater - supported by an exceptionally loyal, friendly and hardworking team - welcome guests to Mount Camdeboo. Not as strangers, but as long forgotten friends. During our 2016, /18/19/24/27, visits here, we travelled up onto the high plateau, overlooking the Manor houses in the valley. From here you can clearly see a measured 170 klms down the valleys towards the sea, in the other direction a distant snow-capped mountain marked the Game Reserve's boundary



As part of our stay at Mount Camdeboo we will be treated to 2 game drives per day, alternating between the high plateau, and the (bit less height) low plateau; drives average about 3-hours each, at optimal wildlife viewing times, namely: pre-dawn & sunset. The vehicles used on the Reserve are purpose-built, game viewing Land Rovers. They are SABS safety approved and are equipped with seatbelts, a shade canopy and drink holders. Given that the Camdeboo Manors are nestled in a valley, the game drives typically start with a breathtaking climb up the mountain slopes, then on to the plateaus above where the animals graze and the world unfolds at your feet,

Mount Camdeboo have introduced more of the traditional species back into the reserve Elephant, Lion and elusive Leopard have all been added, and Camdeboo has now gained Africa "Big 5" status.

The highly knowledgeable and experienced game rangers will try their best to make sure you see our "Camdeboo Favourite 5", breeding cheetah pair, rare white rhinos, giraffe, almost extinct mountain zebra, and "Crazy Gnu" whome, when startled by their blond manes & tails, leap and spin in circles

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## Sat 6<sup>th</sup> May Mount Camdeboo to Pumba Private Game Reserve

After breakfast, we will bid farewell to our friends at Mount Camdeboo and set off with the transfer company for a 3 ½ -hour drive to Pumba Private Game Reserve

**Msenge Chalet** has ELEVEN Glass & bush enclosed chalets flowing naturally into the African bush veld

Gauze and sliding glass doors open onto a private plunge pool, the glass-enclosed chalets provide the illusion that there's nothing separating you & the surrounding bush, ensuring a true African Safari feel.

Four poster beds complete with dreamy white mosquito nets & en-suite bathrooms allow you to become one with nature in the lap of luxury. On a still day, open the doors & listen to the sounds of nature.

Experienced rangers maximize every opportunity to ensure exceptional viewing during your game drive and walks on this vast, established 6,500-hectare game reserve.

Excellent sightings are enjoyed on game drives across the open plains of the reserve. Expect to see lion, elephant, rhino, buffalo, cheetah, hippo, giraffe, hyena, zebra, warthog and many species of antelope.

Large herds of plains game, including eland, gemsbok, springbok, wildebeest and zebra, are all found on this reserve

Pumba boasts diverse vegetation, 5five biomes: savanna grassland, valley bushveld, fynbos, riverine forest and acacia woodland.

With little or no light pollution, night at Pumba is an opportunity to 'hear the silence of Africa', star gaze in wonder at the Southern Hemisphere's Milky Way and identify Orion's Belt, The Southern Cross and Scorpio



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### **THE WHITE LIONS of PUMBA**

In Africa, in this diverse cultural and mystical land steep in African beliefs and secrets, you will be enchanted, fascinated and a changed person when you leave.

White Lions are regarded by African Shangaan tribal elders as the most sacred animal on the African continent, carrying the eternal essence of native African wisdom and a message of crucial importance for all humanity. They believe that the birth of a white lion is a gift from the ancestors, its presence ensuring peace and prosperity for all in the tribal lands.

Tribal members feel that they can walk safely amongst the white lions, protected by the Spirit Guides that they believe are present in the lions.

### **Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> May – Pumba to Kariega Private Game Reserve – The Homestead**

After an early morning game drive, depart Pumba, travel 40-minutes to Kariega main gate, here we check-in at Kariega Game Reserve Reception, then 4WD transfer to the wilderness and the fabulous 4/5 Star “The Homestead” situated on the southern side of the road to the town of Kempton on Sea, that divides Kariega.

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Our party of TWELVE will have **EXCLUSIVE** use of the entire Homestead for the next **FOUR** nights.

We will have the services of our own hosts, chefs, barman, game drive vehicles and game rangers. All bedrooms are king twin / double with ensuites. After checking-in, we will enjoy “high tea” before setting out on the first of our 3-hour game drives. (B,L,D)

The grunt or roar of a lion passing by will certainly get your attention, as you realize that you are really out in the wild. It is common to encounter herds of antelope everywhere

Elephants are also often encountered, whilst out on our daily morning or afternoon game drives
