








- Procedures to keep you safe and ensure great dives for all participants
 All divers are given a Boat Safety Briefing where we explain safe conduct
 and emergency procedures
- All divers must be NITROX certified and will be given our Shark Dive Briefings where we explain the dive site, dives and procedures
- Divers are expected to attend these Briefings where we address all questions and concerns
- Due to dive times, depths & repetitive dives, all diving will be on 32% NITROX
- Divers with less than 30 dives will be assigned a Dive Master for supervision
- Bookings are limited to 20 clients on the Shark Dive to ensure the best possible shark diving experience for everyone
- All divers are required to follow the same dive profile and bottom times
- You will be led to a fixed position for observing the sharks, no personal exploration is allowed
- All divers are required to wear dark, full body wetsuits and black gloves (we will provide if needed)
- White or brightly coloured wetsuits and gear are not allowed, neither is any gear that is shiny
- You are required to act responsibly, remain vigilant and alert us to any problems should they arise
- Our staff are authorised to remove you from the dive or end your dive at any time if you fail to adhere to our procedures





- Over the past three decades, our shark dive has continued to evolve, and our procedures have evolved as well.
- Over the course of tens of thousands of dives, we have developed a unique animal encounter that is not only awe-inspiring, but the thrill of a lifetime.
- Above all else, our main concern has always been to ensure the maximum safety for all involved: animals, tourists and ourselves and things that were possible a few years ago, are not possible anymore, due to the massive increase in numbers of sharks (which is actually a bonus for you, the way we see it).
- As a result of our fine-tuned protocol, most of our clients appreciate the fact they can come within centimetres of some of the biggest apex predators in the world, and consistently rank our dive, as one of their best underwater experiences ever.
- However, a minority of folks find our procedures too restrictive, and we totally understand. If you want to do your own thing, our shark dive is not for you.
- Our dive is a tightly choreographed eco-tourism activity where all participants are being supervised and protected, it is not a "personal adventure".
- You will not be given free rein for individual exploration or one-to-one shark encounters.
- We will not deviate from our procedures, regardless of your shark diving experience, your status and/or the size of ego, camera or wallet.
- We will however extend special treatment to selected full-time industry professionals, but we will always keep full control of the proceedings.

The Fiji Shark Dive

The action begins at 30 metres, we stay here 10-12 minutes overlooking The Arena. In The Arena, the Bull Sharks have celebrity status. We kick off the festivities with a hand feed, then continue with an aerial feed as we drop tuna heads from a bait bin.

Be on the lookout for Tawny Nurse, Sicklefin Lemon, & Silvertip Sharks. Maybe even get a surprise visit from a Tiger Shark, we never know what the dive has in store

Once the first level has concluded, we swim up the to 10m. Here we will spend 10-15 minutes with the Grey Reef and Whitetip Reef Sharks. Our hand feeder at this station will be feeding these species, but also any Lemon, or Silvertip Sharks who show up

Our final stop is at 4metres. Here in the shallows you will be surrounded by Whitetip & Blacktip Reef Sharks. We call them the 'Reef Shark Mafia'. Whitetips have no sense of personal space, don't get crazy if one swims past your head or between your legs

Our hand feeder will be controlling the action as they hand out pieces of bait. While you are enjoying the show, you will be conducting your safety stop at the same time. It will be the best safety stop you will ever make, we guarantee it.

DIVE TWO: The action begins at either 25m or 15m, depth is dependent upon weather and ocean conditions. When we get down, the Bulls are already waiting. Keep a lookout for other special visitors: Lemons, Silvertips, Tawnys and the elusive Tiger.

If we start the dive at 25m, we kick off the festivities with a hand feed. If we start the dive at 15m we go straight into the aerial competition.

Did somebody say 'Sharknado'? There will be more Bulls on this dive than your first one, no joke. And just when you thought it couldn't get any better, you may get blessed with a caudal fin to the face. Consider it an honour!

At 25m we will spend 18-20 minutes with the sharks before we head up the slope and your Dive Master brings you on a coral tour of Shark Reef.

At 15m we spend 28-30 minutes with the sharks before we head up for a safety stop.

We conduct our Safety Stop as a group then head to the surface. That natural high you're feeling? We promise it will stay with you for the rest of the day!

Voli Voli Over 90 Dive Sites

The Bligh Water (also known as The Vatu-I-Ra Passage) hosts an unimaginable amount of structure in the form of coral reefs — some rising from 1000m to 1m in a sheer wall.

With over 90-incredible dive sites, in 9 different regions, accessible by the modern fleet of purpose-built dive boats, everyday will be as exciting as the next.

Boat trips can vary from 12-minutes to 50-minutes depending on sites, and with over 390 different species of coral, and over 2,300 fish species, a lifetime of diving will not be enough.

Sites like Breathtaker, Mellow Yellow, Black Magic Mountain, E-6, Golden Dreams, Dream Maker, Amazing Maze, Heaven's Door, Mt Mutiny and Pure Magic, and so many more, will have you smiling from ear-to-ear, and coming back for more-and-more.

Just be warned, once you've experienced the Bligh Water with the amazing dive team, you may just be spoiled for diving anywhere else!

For those MACRO enthusiasts feel free to explore the 3 House Reefs, these are all 'go-slow' sites, and home to a range of pipefish, sea horses, frogfish, nudibranch, octopus, crustaceans, anemone, and so much more. These 3 House Reefs are great for snorkellers They are super shallow, so spend as long as you like, and as you're staying on a dive package these are available completely free-of-charge 24x7x365 – unlimited, that's right, dive the 3 House Reefs whenever you wish.

General Diving Rules

Obviously on all dive tours, safety is our main concern. The quality of diving is guaranteed. We must dive within our limits and stay safe.

NITROX is strongly recommended and will need to be booked in advance.

You must carry an SMB, whistle, snorkel & alternate air source.

Snorkelers: Non-Divers, aka Snorkellers, are welcome on the tour. Some dive sites are suitable for competent snorkellers to join us,if there is room on the boat. Cost \$AU 54 per day

Note that snorkelling activity is not normally guided nor supervised, and as such should be undertaken with a "buddy", which is highly recommended for safety, and vastly increases the overall enjoyment of the day. There are plenty of activities for non-divers both in the resort and around it.

Travel Insurance is compulsory on all of our tours. We strongly recommend taking out travel insurance when paying your deposit.

Consider paying for part of the tour with your credit card, and take out the Travel Insurance that is (if) attached to it

We suggest carefully checking conditions of any travel insurance you may be considering.

Please note that DAN Insurance does not cover you for things such as flight cancellations, lost baggage or similar. They only cover you for diving related injuries. Additional insurance is compulsory to cover cancellations, airline changes and baggage as well as DAN.

FLIGHTS: Qantas, Virgin, Fiji, JetStar (yuk) Airlines are included with an allowance of \$AU 900 as at May 2025.

Booking for flights is best 6-months prior to get best prices. Late bookings will very likely encounter more expensive airfares
