

What to expect...



The Maldives

The Maldives is an island nation in the Indian Ocean, consisting of a double chain of twenty-six atolls, containing 1192 islands, 192 of which are inhabited. The Maldives are orientated north to south and stretch over 1200 kilometres.

We will generally make three dives daily, with twoor three-night dives as well.

The diving is nothing short of spectacular.

Our first dive will be very sharky. Expect mid-water dozens of Spinner and Nurse Sharks and keep an eye out to the deep for Bull & maybe Tiger Sharks.

Manta Rays abound in the Maldives, and with so many "hot spots" to see them at, you will not be disappointed.

The guides are dive instructors or dive masters who have years of experience in the Maldives and will ensure that you get to enjoy the best diving available during your time there.

The satellite image to the right will give you an idea of the vastness of the Maldives water nation.

Diving is all conducted off a traditional "Dhoni", all of your dive equipment stays onboard the "Dhoni" for the entirety of the voyage. All you need to do is get onboard in your swimmers after the dive briefing, and at the end of the dive hop back onto our liveaboard again. Two of the huge benefits of this is there's no noise from the compressors after the dive, and that the entire yacht is dry and luxurious.



Maldives 2026

The Diving

The Maldives islands are flat with white sandy beaches and excellent reefs with an abundance of marine life. Scuba diving is done at a leisurely drift pace as the Indian Monsoon Current sweeps along the island chains, moving nutrients and divers along.

This nutrient-rich water flows up along the walls, feeding the sponges and soft corals clinging to the rock sides. Inside the atoll lagoons, rock pinnacles – thilas – vault up from the bottom to scratch the water's surface.

In the channels, there are swimthroughs, caverns and overhangs festooned with colorful sponges, invertebrates and gorgonians to explore. At well-known cleaning stations, wrasse and shrimp service manta rays, and other large marine species.

In the open ocean near the reefs, pelagic animals – including manta rays, eagle rays, tuna and a variety of sharks (including whale sharks) – frequent the Maldives. On shallow dives, the clear, bright blue water hosts a massive number of sweet lips, parrotfish, groupers, snappers as well as frequent turtles and SO many eels.




